the Commissioners' Courtroom in Woodville, Texas, the following members of the Court

The invocation was delivered by Judge Blanchette.

A motion was made by Commissioner Walston and seconded by Commissioner Marshall
to approve the minutes of November 12, 2007. All voted yes and none no.

The County Auditor called attention to an additional invoice for lawyer's insurance for
Jerome Owens, District Judge. This is not a budgeted item. A motion was made by
Commissioner Nash and seconded by **Commissioner Hughes** to approve paying the
bills, including the lawyer's liability insurance for Judge Owens, as submitted by the
County Auditor. All voted and none no. SEE ATTACHED CLAIMS LIST

Commissioner Walston motioned to approve the **line item transfers** as presented by the
County Auditor. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Nash**. All voted yes and
none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Hughes** to approve the **County Treasurer's**
monthly report. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded this motion. All voted yes and
none no. SEE ATTACHED REPORT

Mike Walker and David Waxman presented the projected cuts to come within the
funding of the **grant** for **generators** and installation for sites in **Tyler County and the**
Tyler County Hospital. By deleting fencing, shed covers, and installation of generators
for Rockland and Seneca Water Supply, the lowest bid from McKinney & McMillan
would come within budget. Hopefully Tyler County Water Supply and Seneca Water
Supply can fund the shortfall. A motion was made by **Commissioner Walston** and
seconded by **Commissioner Hughes** to award the **bid** to McKinney and McMillan from
Jacksonville with the changes as presented by Mr. Walker and Mr. Waxman. All voted
yes and none no.

Commissioner Marshall motioned to grant a permit for a gas **pipeline** beneath **CR 4400**
in **Precinct #3**. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Walston**. All voted yes
and none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Walston** and seconded by **Commissioner Nash**
to grant a permit for a gas **pipeline** beneath **CR 4320** in **Precinct #4**. All voted yes and
none no. SEE ATTACHED

Item #9 was deferred until Mr. Powers could be present to present a contract from
Netdata for Justice of Peace, Pct. #3.

By conference call, Milton Powers, reported the cost of \$39,000 for a five year contract for **case management software** for Justice of Peace for Precincts #2, #3 and #4. Bill Moser, representing Netdata, called attention to the maintenance being an annual fee. JP #1 already has this software. A motion was made by **Commissioner Nash** and seconded by **Commissioner Walston** to approve the purchase of the software. Commissioner Nash and Commissioner Walston moved to amended their motion to include this purchase will not be paid until 2008 due to allowance in the budget. All voted yes and none no.

Alex Rawls, Sr. presented a request for a statement of "no opposition" on behalf of **IMEX, Inc. Recycling Facility** to be located on 17.53 acres in the M.McCormick Survey, Abst. #472.(old Allison Pole Mill site) **Commissioner Marshall** was concerned about the court being responsible for environmental issues and motioned to table this item until it could be reviewed by Joe Smith. **Commissioner Walston** seconded this motion. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Walston** to advertise for proposals on **workers compensation**, as requested by Joyce Moore. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded this motion. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Marshall motioned to appoint Robert Allison to the **Tyler County Hospital Board** replacing Jim Parker who had moved out of Precinct #3. **Commissioner Walston** seconded this motion. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Walston motioned to approve the disposal of **office equipment** from the **county clerk's department** being an old Minolta 4233 copier and a broken Okidata 321 printer. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

Sandy Abshire presented an **employment and training assistance program** called "Experience Works". The federal government pays **wages** while they are learning for age 55 and older participants who meet eligibility guidelines. This program allows 20 hours a week for a period of six months with a cap of two years. This was an informational presentation only and no action was taken.


Commissioner Walston motioned the meeting adjourned. Commissioner Hughes seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

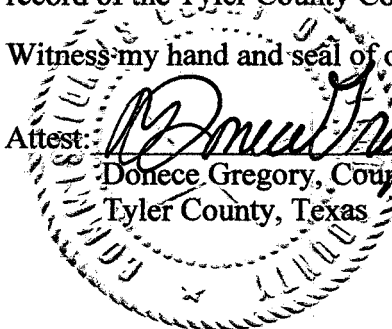

I.

Springfield Pipeline Company, LLC, ("Springfield") whose principal business address is 1201 Lake Robbins Drive, The Woodlands, Texas 77380, does hereby apply for a permit as hereinafter provided to utilize and cross beneath Tyler County Road 4400 ("CR 4400"), collectively referred to as "county road".

II.

Springfield is a natural gas utility under the Texas Utilities Code § 121.000, *et seq* and is a gatherer, transporter and purchaser of natural gas produced by various wells, including but not limited to the Anadarko Petroleum Well, in Jasper County, Texas situated in the A. Issacs Survey, Abstract No. 316.

III.

Springfield will construct, operate and maintain a pipeline, not greater than twelve inches (12") in diameter, to transport natural gas produced from the Anadarko well. Said pipeline will cross CR 4400, seven tenths (0.7) of a mile, west state hwy. 92.

IV.

Springfield will construct, operate and maintain the pipeline in a good and workman-like manner, in compliance with ordinary care in the pipeline industry and in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

V.

Springfield will construct the pipeline using ordinary care across the rights-of-way for CR 4400 to a depth of up to ten feet (10'), but not less than six feet (6') below the crest of the county

road. Springfield will restore the surface of the county road to the same or better condition than its current condition.

VI.

Springfield hereby indemnifies and agrees to hold Tyler County and its officials harmless from any and all claims for personal injury (including death), damage to equipment, supplies or personal property or other claims which arise from Springfield's negligent use of the CR 4400 rights-of-way.

VII.

It is agreed that for the consideration stated in this permit, including indemnifying Tyler County and burying the pipeline up to ten feet, but not less than six feet below the crest of CR 4400, Springfield shall not be required by Tyler County, the Commissioners' Court of Tyler County or the Tyler County Judge to remove the pipeline crossing CR 4400. However, Springfield shall be required to relocate said pipeline only if doing so becomes necessary due to a bona fide public emergency. The relocation shall be within Springfield's thirty-foot rights-of-way beneath CR 4400. Tyler County, the Commissioners' Court of Tyler County and/or the Tyler County Judge shall not require Springfield to relocate the pipeline except for public emergencies, including, but not limited to allowing widening or other changing of any traffic lane. Springfield will remove and relocate the gathering line at its sole cost and expense upon ninety (90) days written notification by Tyler County.

VIII.

Tyler County makes no warranty of title or representation of its right to use the rights-of-way for CR 4400.

IX.



CROSSING COUNTY RD. NO. 4400**

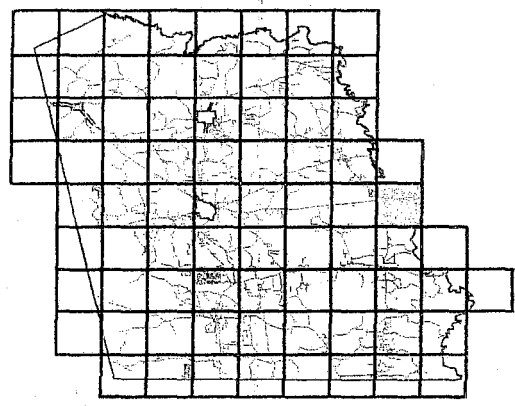
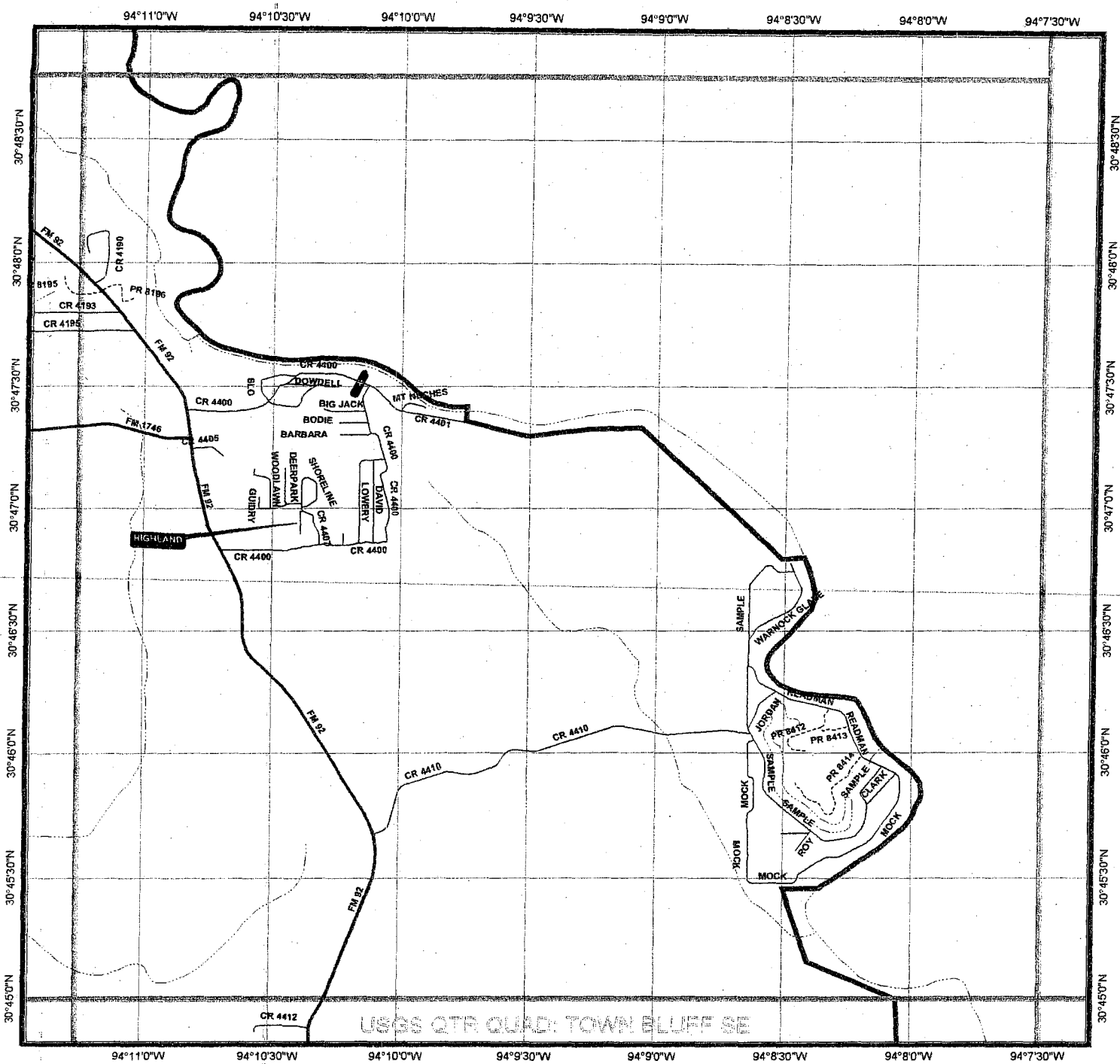

Springfield is a natural gas utility under the Texas Utilities Code § 121.000, *et seq* and is a gatherer, transporter and purchaser of natural gas produced by various wells, including but not limited to the Anadarko Petroleum Well, in Jasper County, Texas situated in the A. Issacs Survey, Abstract No. 316.

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road. Springfield will restore the surface of the county road to the same or better condition than its current condition.

VI.

Springfield hereby indemnifies and agrees to hold Tyler County and its officials harmless from any and all claims for personal injury (including death), damage to equipment, supplies or personal property or other claims which arise from Springfield's negligent use of the CR 4320 rights-of-way.

VII.

It is agreed that for the consideration stated in this permit, including indemnifying Tyler County and burying the pipeline up to ten feet, but not less than six feet below the crest of CR 4320, Springfield shall not be required by Tyler County, the Commissioners' Court of Tyler County or the Tyler County Judge to remove the pipeline crossing CR 4320. However, Springfield shall be required to relocate said pipeline only if doing so becomes necessary due to a bona fide public emergency. The relocation shall be within Springfield's thirty-foot rights-of-way beneath CR 4320. Tyler County, the Commissioners' Court of Tyler County and/or the Tyler County Judge shall not require Springfield to relocate the pipeline except for public emergencies, including, but not limited to allowing widening or other changing of any traffic lane. Springfield will remove and relocate the gathering line at its sole cost and expense upon ninety (90) days written notification by Tyler County.

VIII.

Tyler County makes no warranty of title or representation of its right to use the rights-of-way for CR 4320.

IX.

Springfield and the Commissioners' Court of Tyler County, Texas agree that use of the right-of-way shall be limited to the purpose stated herein. By execution hereof in the space provided below, Springfield hereby applies for the permit as stated herein and Tyler County, Texas does hereby grant a permit to Springfield for use of its rights-of-way for CR 4320.

X.

Springfield is required to pay a \$200.00 Administration Fee to Tyler County Commissioners' Precinct where line will be located. Payment is due prior to time of approval by Tyler County Commissioners' Court. Payment may be made payable by check, cashiers check, or money order.

This program, funded under Title V of the Older Americans Act as well as state and local grants, enables us to help thousands of low-income individuals, age 55 and older, throughout the United States.

- Participants are placed at eligible host agencies* (primarily at faith-based and community organizations) for which they are paid the minimum wage for an average of 20 hours per week.
- Nationally, in the 2005-06 program year, we served more than 23,000 seniors, and provided services to more than 8,650 nonprofit and public organizations in 39 states and territories. Seniors on our programs contributed more than 11 million hours of community service while living productive and independent lives.
