Commissioner Walston delivered the invocation. Judge Blanchette led the pledge to the  
Texas Flag.

A motion was made by Commissioner Walston and seconded by Commissioner Marshall  
to table approval of the minutes of August 11, 2008. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Hughes** and seconded by **Commissioner Nash** to  
approve paying **bills**, as presented by the **County Auditor**. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Walston** and seconded by **Commissioner  
Marshall** to approve line item transfers as presented by the **County Auditor**:

The County Auditor explained that the county website provided by Texas Association of  
Counties and funded by County Information Resources Agency (CIRA) had the potential  
of being a really nice website. Being that most of the information that should be on it  
comes from the County Judge's office, she recommended the judge's assistant, Audrey  
Pelly be a co-administrator. A motion was made by **Commissioner Nash** to appoint  
Audrey Pelly, assistant to County Judge and Rhonda Hall, assistant to County Auditor as  
CIRA Co-administrators. **Commissioner Hughes** seconded the motion. All voted yes  
and none no.

Joe Smith pointed out that due to the privacy nature and his office having access to  
descriptive illegal drug information, the employee physicals and random drug test results  
should come directly to his department. He would then contact the department heads.  
They would be advising the department heads as to legal procedures of terminating  
employment. **Commissioner Walston** motioned that due to the privacy act, the test  
results would go from the physicians and hospital to the Criminal District Attorney's  
office. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded the motion. Sharon Fuller suggested the  
entire "packet" (i.e. random selection by the hospital and notification) be handled by Mr.  
Smith's office and not her office. Commissioner Walston stated those duties needed to  
stay with the County Treasurer; that, only the results would be transferred to Mr. Smith's  
office. Lou Cloy suggested the employee's policy manual needed to be updated. She was  
reviewing one from Jefferson County. All voted yes and none no.

**Commissioner Walston** motioned to renew the Hazard Mitigation Action plan as  
presented by John Paul Feely. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Nash**. All  
voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED ORDER

A motion was made by **Commissioner Nash** and seconded by **Commissioner Walston** to table filling the vacancy on the **RSVP Advisory Board** until the court can get the qualifications needed. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Walston** and seconded by **Commissioner Marshall** to table filling the vacancy on the **Tyler County Historical Commission**. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Nash** and seconded by **Commissioner Hughes** to approve the line item transfer for the **Juvenile Probation Department**. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED LINE ITEM TRANSFER

**INFORMATIONAL PRESENTATIONS:**

Carlos Bullock delivered a comprehensive presentation of the services provided and goals of the **Alabama-Coushatta Tribal Council**:

- Tribal chiefs are elected to a life term
- The median household income is \$21,000
- One of the first Head Start programs still in operation
- Received a grant for establishing a tribal court
- Working to get tribal police
- Health service clinics experience budget cuts
- Senior citizens are provided a daily meal and periodic outings
- Fire Department and Emergency Management
- Recreation through softball leagues and youth 4H and youth Unity
- Three churches on the reservation; very much a Christian community
- Churches now support gaming because of the need for jobs

Kyle Williams gave insight to an upcoming rally for Youth to be held September 19 & 20<sup>th</sup>. It will be an educational program about drugs, teen pregnancy, STDs, etc.

Judge Blanchette commended the POW-WOW he had attended.

Mary Ann Saenz, representing Texas Association of Counties, presented her recommendations for updates to the **employee policy manual**:

- Separate drug policy for CDL drivers
- Return to work policy on worker's compensation
- Emergency closing
- Harassment
- Hipaa/Cobra notification for new hires

**INFORMATIONAL REPORTS:**

Commissioner Nash will be offering free mulch from 8am-noon for the month of September.

Joe Smith recommend reconsideration, as an action item on the next agenda, of the contract for the jail needs survey. He reported the contract states the venue and jurisdiction would be in Florida. This needs to be changed to Tyler County in the event of litigation. Judge Blanchette commented that a representative of that firm had told him to make the changes and initial them. Lou Cloy suggested they send replacement pages to the contract.

Donece Gregory reported a meeting of potential bidders for the JB Best building was held on Tuesday.

Rod Morgan, representing the Sheriff's Posse, updated the court concerning the purchase and use of their search and rescue equipment.


A motion was made by Commissioner Walston and seconded by Commissioner Nash for the meeting to adjourn. All voted yes and none no.

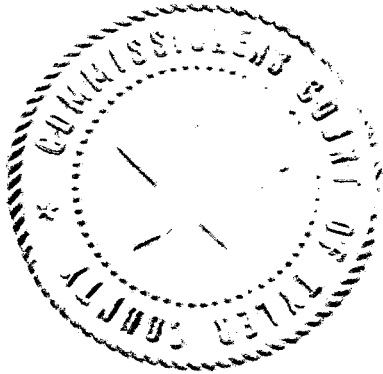

# ALABAMA-COUSHATTA TRIBE OF TEXAS



## Alabama-Coushatta Tribal Timeline

- 1541- First recorded mention of the Tribe by Hernando DeSoto. State of Alabama taken from tribal name Allibamu.
- 1787- After migrating from present Alabama with stops in Mississippi and Louisiana tribe arrived in Mexico
- 1831- Tribe considered for land grant from Mexican government
- 1836- Tribe entered into treaty with "Provisional Government of Texas" along with Cherokee Indians and associate bands. Treaty was not ratified by later administration in 1837
- 1836- Assisted fleeing settlers during "Runaway Scrape"
- 1854- General Sam Houston established 1110 acre reservation for Alabama Tribe
- 1880- US Census first lists tribal members
- 1910- US Census lists 192 members on the reservation
- 1924- American Indians become citizens
- 1928- Tribe becomes federally recognized, US government allots 3200 acres of additional reservation land
- 1934- Polk County Indians formed a school district
- World War II- 47 Tribal Members served in the armed services
- 1948- Attorney General confirms voting rights of Tribal Members
- 1954- Tribe terminated as federally recognized tribe through the federal policy, trust responsibility transferred to the State of Texas
- 1963- Texas allocates \$40,000 to finance a museum, restaurant, and arts and crafts shop.
- 1970- Mutual Help Housing constructed on the reservation
- August 18, 1987- Federal Recognition restored to Tribe under PL 100-89

## The Tribe that assisted settlers become Texas

The Alabama-Coushatta Tribe located in the Big Thicket of Deep East Texas is one of only three federally recognized tribes in Texas. The Tribe has a rich history that dates back before the state of Texas itself. This historic legacy extends from current day Alabama and the migration west to our current reservation in Polk County.

Preserving our culture and language is a priority of the Tribe, but we also want to educate others of our contribution to the Great State of Texas. In 1836 the Tribe played a significant role in assisting panicked settlers fleeing the fighting between the Texian Army and the Mexican Army. The families of the Texian soldiers were part of the "Runaway Scrape" and the Tribe shared intimate knowledge of the land while providing food and shelter to the wandering settlers. Tribal members assistance gave Texian soldiers peace of mind, which allowed them to successfully defeat the Mexican Army.

For the Tribe's efforts General Sam Houston dedicated land on behalf of the Alabama and Coushatta Tribes. In the following years Sam Houston became a true friend of the Tribe, and often met with tribal members when he visited nearby Huntsville. The Tribe seeks to inform and educate the public of the Tribe's relationship with General Sam Houston and the early settlers of Texas.

The Tribe played a significant role in the history of Texas, but very few know of the Tribes contributions. The Tribe wants to educate, but also preserve our own heritage for future generations. Tribal Elders have long wanted to preserve our language which remains strong today, and also share our unique culture with our surrounding communities. The Tribe will continue to live in a changing world while respecting our past.

In recognition for our support during the war for Texas independence, Sam Houston granted 1,110.7 acres in what is now Polk County. Houston promised that the rights of the Alabama-Coushatta Tribe would always be respected by Texas and the federal government.

Our economic hardship was compounded when the Alabama-Coushatta Tribe was targeted by Jack Abramoff's corrupt schemes. In 2001, the illegal activities of Abramoff and others led to the loss of gaming and derailed our plan for self-sufficiency. The U.S. Congress and the state of Texas have the ability to right this wrong, and they should.

The Alabama-Coushatta Tribe are proud people. We don't want a handout. All we seek is the right to game—the same right enjoyed by the Kickapoo Tribe in southwest Texas and every other federally-recognized tribe in the United States.

Restoring the Tribal casino will not only help the economy on the reservation, it will create employment and business opportunity for our neighbors in Polk and Tyler counties. It will be a big boost to tourism for the entire region.

Gaming will allow the Alabama-Coushatta Tribe to achieve economic self-sufficiency and create better lives for our children and our neighbors. But without the right to game and reopen our casino, our options are extremely limited.
