A motion was made by Commissioner Walston and seconded by Commissioner Nash to approve the minutes of December 12th and December 22, 2008. All voted yes and none no, including Judge Blanchette.

Judge Blanchette informed the court that he would be becoming a "voting member" in all actions. In the past, he had only voted in case of a tie vote.

The County Clerk explained this fee is charged by the District Clerk in every civil case as part of the court cost. A motion was made by **Commissioner Hughes** to approve amending the **sheriff's jury fee** back to \$10. **Commissioner Nash** seconded the motion. All members of the court voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Walston motioned to approve the Official Bonds of the Sheriff,
Commissioner Pct. #1 and Commissioner Pct. #3, Constables of Precinct 1,2,3 and 4.
Commissioner Nash seconded the motion. All members of the court voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Walston motioned to adopt the state mileage allowance of 55 cents per mile for travel reimbursement as of January 7th. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Marshall. All members of the court voted yes and none no.

Sharon Fuller, County Treasurer, entered the meeting.

Sheriff Hennigan presented the new cost of purchasing two patrol vehicles, with cameras, push bumpers, and control boxes, for the Sheriff's department. Commissioner Hughes motioned to approve the purchase of the patrol vehicles at the new price. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Marshall. All members of the court voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

Sheriff Hennigan presented two proposals for purchase of a pick-up truck for the **Sheriff**. **Commissioner Nash** motioned to approve the less expensive vehicle being the 2008 Toyota Tundra Super Crew. **Commissioner Hughes** seconded the motion. This will be paid from Marshall Funds and balance of budgeted amount. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

Judge Blanchette introduced local taxpayers that are members of the jail review committee.

Commissioners Court January 7, 2009

Margo Frasier, representing MGT of America, Inc. presented their results of the jail needs study:

- Increase capacity of jail by 37 beds by 2018 (total capacity of 80 beds)
- Continue using alternatives such as the pre-trial supervision program
- Alternative program for check writing offenses. For example, using citations.
- Conduct a comprehensive review of data system. For example, system triggers report that person is still in jail after being sentenced to prison.
- Use additional capacity to address the warrant backlog and house inmates under a contract
- Not to expand where the jail is presently located

Terri Allen, Juvenile Probation Officer, entered the meeting

Court took a 20 minutes recess. COURT IN SESSION: 3:00 pm

Joe Smith and Commissioner Hughes was of the opinion that adding 37 beds would not be adequate due to the beds needed now if all the warrants were served, including probation revocation and city prisoners. Commissioner Hughes added the inadequacy of not being able to house Federal prisoners to get revenue for the county. Commissioner Nash remembered that officials from the jail commission agreed after meeting with the court that the need would be around 96 beds. He felt the jail commission would not "sign off" due to a report of needing only additional 37 beds. The commissioners and the judge also felt the population projection was low and not accurate. Mr. Smith stated that 25-30% of the offenses are committed by people who are not residents of the county. He felt this number was not taken into the population factor. Having four major highways, "Big Thicket", recreational area, etc. needed to be factored into the projected number of beds.

David Hennigan stated he heard that the study recommended a minimum of 96 beds, but agreed with some members of the court that 144 were more realistic. Mr. Hennigan felt the computer system was antiquated and not able to get data that MGT needed for the study. Judge Blanchette added the court needed to be able to build the amount of beds needed yet be sensitive to the ability to pay for it by the taxpayers. Vernon Lewis stated he didn't want to build something that is so small that will have to be rebuilt in 10 years, also the data needed will be what drives the public in their decision. Judge reminded that Sheriff Wolf saw a marked a difference and increase of the criminal element in the county since Hurricanes Rita, and influx of evacuees of Hurricane Katrina; therefore, he was not able to house as many Federal prisoners. Commission Nash stated that if we keep the justice system exactly as it is now then 96 beds would suffice; but, if we want to address the 7000 warrants, the probation offenders, hot check offenders, etc. then 96 beds is not enough, but how do we get that information "signed off on". Ms. Frasier emphasized that the 96 beds was to house Tyler County prisoners only: with the justice system now in place (using the alternative and juggling methods). If the taxpayers want a more aggressive system and help to fund it by using federal prisoners, then county needs to look at the 144 bed unit. The Warden reminded that Polk County had built a 1000 bed unit to house federal prisoners that would be more attractive to the Feds, due to airport and convenience.

Bruce Strickland stated that the flat line of projected misdemeanors was incorrect because the felony inmates pushed the number of misdemeanors down. Those misdemeanors are still out there. Joe agreed he files twice as many misdemeanors cases as felonies. Margo stated she felt the data had been artificially suppressed because there has not been any room in the jail to serve the warrants and house more offenders. Joe Smith wanted MGT to go back and reevaluate the problems and questions about the misdemeanor data. Since 1998, there has only been one court hearing for misdemeanor revocations. There is probably 20-30 defendants each month that need to go to jail for misd. revocations.

Linda Johnson, taxpayer, stated she was for putting people in jail and building a "big fine jail", but to find other ways of funding the cost, such as bail bonding boards, instead of increasing taxes.

A motion was made by Commissioner Walston and seconded by Commissioner Nash to adjourn the meeting.





Evaluation of the Tyler County Criminal Justice System

January 7, 2009

MGT

Background

- On August 26, 2008, Tyler County hired MGT to evaluate the justice system to determine whether additional jail capacity is needed.
- To perform the evaluation, MGT personnel:
 - Interviewed elected officials, staff, and stakeholders;
 - Toured the facility;
 - Analyzed data provided by Net Data and Tyler County;
 and
 - Conducted a peer analysis.



Recommendations

- Increase capacity of jail by 37 beds by 2018 (total capacity of 80 beds).
- Increase space provided in jail for program services and support services:
 - Space is currently inadequate; and
 - Need for additional space will become more pronounced as jail population grows.



Recommendations II

- Continue using alternatives to incarceration, including the pre-trial supervision program.
- Develop a program alternative specifically targeted at those accused of check writing offenses.
- Develop detailed policy and procedures for the issuance of citations for Class B misdemeanors.



Recommendations III

- Conduct a comprehensive review of data system and management reporting needs.
- Identify necessary data not being recorded in the Net Data system.
- Work with Net Data to develop or enhance the county's system-reporting capability.
- Develop a management reporting system to monitor the performance of each area of the local justice system.




Population Growth

Violent Crime Rate


Tyler County Violent Crime Rate






Property Crime Rate

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


Incarceration Rate






Populations inside the Tyler ty Jail System


Felony Population

Average Number of Felony Beds Used Daily






Felony Population Projection

Probation Revocation Population


Average Daily Number of Beds Used for Probation Revocation






Probation Revokee Population Projection

Number of Beds Used Daily for Probation Revocation






Misdemeanant Population



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Misdemeanant Population Projection


Daily Misdemeanant Bed Use


MGT Other Beds Used Other Bed Use

Jail Population Projection






Jail Population Projection II

- Tyler County will need to house an average daily population of 73 inmates by 2018.
- The peak population of the jail will likely be 80 inmates in 2018.
- As female inmates must be kept separate from male inmates, the female population is projected separately (although included in the total).

Use of Excess Space

- Tyler County will not immediately require 80 jail beds.
- In the interim, the additional capacity can be used to address the warrant backlog and/or to house inmates under a contract.



Federal Contract Inmates

- Federal contract inmates were not included in the future projection.
- MGT recommends that the Sheriff's Office and the Commissioners Court decide how many (if any) contract inmates the jail would seek to house on a long term basis (as opposed to the interim) and add that number to the projection.



Capacity Management

- Currently there is only one room within the jail for programs and it cannot hold 43 inmates.
- The current kitchen and laundry are too small for the current jail population.



Justice System Processes

- Court system appears to be efficient.
- Recent legislation allows for the use of citations for Class B misdemeanors and MGT recommends that the Sheriff's Office and the Woodville Police Department develop a policy on using these citations.



Alternatives to Incarceration

- Tyler County makes reasonable use of jail diversion programs as a means of controlling the jail population.
- Additional areas for which programs could be developed are:
 - Bad check writing;
 - Traffic offenses; and
 - Class C misdemeanors.



Information Management

- Although the reports provided by Net Data are useful, Tyler County needs more interactive capability to monitor and address a growing jail population.
- Common justice system performance measures are included in MGT's report.
- Tyler County and Net Data should determine whether these measures can be generated by data in the computer systems.
