living and increase to minimum wage

Commissioner Nash- major transfer of funds to jail and disaster relief looks like an
increase to the budget but really its not.

One time expense- J. B. Best building renovation and Cost Of Living Assessment
(COLA) for retirees

Commissioner Walston- expounded on Commissioner Nash's comments - last hurricane
could have cost the county \$2 million dollars and the 75/25 percentage rate.

J. B. Best building renovations is a "sore spot" with oil companies because of no room in
the county clerk's office.

Rate levied last year ---.3671 This rate could remain the same


County Judge- Total impact of grants leverages purchasing power. Commissioners
court met with state agencies to set a precedent to get contract changed did not only
benefit Tyler County but other counties as well. County has a good leadership team.
