Jack Walston presented and introduced Kevin Gee to put forward the bids opened last week for supplemental work being paid for by Hurricane Rita funds. David Waxman recommended making a conditional award until clearance has been received from the State. Commissioner Nash inquired if the companies were aware of the time constraints and could get the work done within the time frame. Mr. Waxman and Mr. Gee answered in the affirmative. A motion was made by Commissioner Walston to award 2007 TCDP Critical Infrastructure Project (DRS705) Supplemental Work Package #1, Section A to Horton Excavating, Lufkin TX.; and, award the 2007 TCDP Critical Infrastructure Project (DRS705) Supplemental Work Package #1, Section B to Diamond K, Cleveland, TX.
