A motion was made by Commissioner Hughes and seconded by Commissioner Marshall to transfer the 1994 Ford Aerostar Van (IFMCAIIU6RZB23632) from **Precinct #2** to the inventory of **Emergency Management.** All voted yes and none no. SEE FIXED ASSET REPORT.

A motion was made by Commissioner Walston and seconded by Commissioner Marshall to approve paying the deductible of \$1000 to repair the patrol vehicle from the Sheriff's budget. All voted yes and none no.

Sandi Hargrove, Huntley Kenneson and Ray Hensarling proposed filing a grant application for Round VI of the Texas Historical Courthouse Preservation. Because of recent water coming in the courthouse, they recommended applying for the emergency funding for the windows and possible grant funds for plans and specifications. Commissioner Nash wanted to see local citizen financial support. Judge Blanchette called Chris Hutson, a staff member of the Volz architect firm who fielded questions in the absence of John Volz, during the meeting to clarify whether the cost quote included the plans and specifications. It included the plans & specifications for the window project only. Mr. Hutson stated the \$330,843 cost did include window protection against condensation of the air conditioning units, as well as necessary drainage from the units. Judge Blanchette motioned to adopt the resolution seeking grant funding and appropriating \$330,843 for plans & specifications required in addition to the total work for windows on the 1891 structure to be preserved and protected. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hughes. This will be paid with the \$100,000 already established in the 2009 budget plus \$230,843 out of contingency from the 2010 budget. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED RESOLUTION

A motion was made by Commissioner Nash and seconded by Commissioner Walston for the meeting to adjourn. All voted yes and none no.

#### **RECAP NOTES**

### relative to the Texas Historic Courthouse Preservation Program Round VI Resolution

- According to Sandi Hargrove, Volz has agreed to do a proposal requesting *emergency funds* to repair windows <u>and</u> for plans and specifications at a cost of \$500 which would come out of the County Historical Commission line item. (010-401-049)
- Courthouse restoration budget line item: (010-453-047)
  - **2009 has \$100,198.47**
  - 2010 approved amount \$100,000 (in Budget Workshop verified by Joyce)
  - As of 1/1/10 \$200,198.47? Does this line item carry over from year to year?
- According to an email from Volz, sent to Sandi Hargrove, regarding proposal requesting <u>both</u> emergency funds for window <u>and plans & specifications</u>:
  - Estimated proposal cost: \$393,990.00 with A/E fees (unsure if fees are included or in addition)
  - If request is fully funded, the county's match will be at minimum \$143,990.00
- According to the email received (11/20 4:21PM) in the county Judge's office from Volz:
  - The total amount a county can receive for emergency funding is \$250,000.00.
  - Tyler County received an emergency grant of \$147,454.00 (for electrical) during Round III.
  - Calculating that information, the emergency amount available to the county is \$102,546.00.
  - Volz says the county's share would be \$330,843.00 for the emergency window work.
  - Calculating with that information Volz is estimating the cost to repair the windows to be \$433,389.00.
- According to this information the county's potential cost would be:
  - \$143,990.00 minimum match for grant if approved as written
  - \* \$330,843.00 county's additional share for the emergency window work

\$474,833.00 county's obligation if grant as proposed is approved

Recommend having Chris Hutson verify this information or correct it if it is inaccurately interpreted.

Hi, Sandra!

To summarize our telephone conversation of this morning, we will revise various pages of the Round V Grant Application to reflect changes that have occurred within the past two years. We will apply for plans and specifications and emergency funding of historic window restoration which is estimated to cost approximately \$393,990.00 with A/E fees. Tyler County will need to match with \$143,990.00 at minimum. Since funding is limited this round, THC may decide to deduct emergency funds awarded previously, thus the County would need to match with additional funds in that amount.

For the application, you and/or the county need provide the following:

- 1. Section IV information: Any new information that would support Architectural Significance.
- 2. Section V information: Any new information that would support Endangerment.
- 3. Section VI information: Any new information that would support Historic Significance.
- 4. Section VIII information: Any new information that would demonstrate a) County incentives for Historic Preservation & b) efforts to protect and enhance surrounding resources.
- 5. Section VIIID information: Any new information related to the Records Management Plan
- 6. Section XIV information: Update on Compliance with State Courthouse Laws date and project approved by THC
- 7. Resolution of support from Commissioners' Court.
- 8. Signature of the Judge on the last page of the application (note: it would be best if Judge Blanchette could email his signature to me to place on the application electronically because the number of pages will vary from the online application on the THC website due to the text I will add. If he is not comfortable with the electronic signature, I will need a manual signature.).
- 9. Letter of transmittal from the Judge addressed to THC indicating that we are submitting revised sections for includsion with the Round V application that will be rolled forward for Round VI, in accordance with information on THC's website.
- 10. Description of and costs for capital improvements reviewed and approved by THC, excluding those for which Tyler County received emergency funding from THC, for use in completing the County Match Requirement.

I will be working on the application next Tuesday, so I need all of the information by Monday. I understand that items #7, #8, & #9 above will be delivered to my office on Wednesday.
