THE STATE OF TEXAS ON THIS THE 14th day of December, 2009 the Commissioners' Court in and for Tyler County, Texas convened in a Regular Meeting at the Commissioners' Courtroom in Woodville, Texas, the following members of the Court present, to wit:

The invocation was delivered by Terry Stockman, pastor of First Baptist Church, Colmesneil. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Judge Blanchette.

A motion was made by Commissioner Nash and seconded by Commissioner Marshall to approve the minutes of November 9th, 13th and 23rd. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Marshall motioned to approve items on the consent agenda: monthly reports of Adult Probation and Juvenile Probation, County Clerk, County Auditor, County Treasurer, Justice of Peace, Pct. #1 and County Extension departments Commissioner Hughes seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

A motion was made by Commissioner Walston and seconded by Commissioner Marshall to approve the allowances and accounts payable, as submitted by the County Auditor. All voted yes and none no.

The County Auditor opened and read aloud proposals received for the **Annual Audit FY'09** with a three year option: Patillo Brown and Hill, Waco, TX - \$25,000 and Alexander Lankford Hires, Lufkin, TX – maximum of \$34,900. A motion was made by **Commissioner Walston** and seconded by **Commissioner Marshall** to table consideration of these proposals until Friday, December 18th, for further study. All voted yes and none no.

The County Auditor opened and read aloud bids received for the **Rough Terrain Fork Lift:** Playgrounds Today, Inc. - \$825 John M Lade - \$658

James Robbins - \$1525

Commissioner Nash made a motion and it was seconded by Commissioner Walston to table consideration of the bids until Friday, December 18th, for further study. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Judge Blanchette** and seconded by **Commissioner Marshall** to approve payment of the invoice from Garner Environmental Services in the amount of \$88,965.19. Commissioner Nash suggested the county needs to bill the entities for generators and other services provided in the aftermath of Hurricane Ike. It was a consensus of the court that the entities be billed for their share of this invoice. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED STATEMENT

Sheriff Hennigan explained that stolen property had been found and the department did not have a vehicle with lowboy capability to recover it. Therefore, due to the emergency situation of recovering the property, an officer used his personal truck and it was damaged at the location of the property. Commissioner Nash motioned to approve reimbursement of an officer from the Sheriff's department for damage to his personal vehicle. Commissioner Hughes seconded the motion. Commissioner Nash recommended the sheriff use a road & bridge precinct truck next time instead of a personal vehicle. All voted yes and none no.

Sheriff Hennigan informed the court that he had saved enough funds out of his budget to be able to purchase a "3rd vehicle". A motion was made by **Commissioner Nash** and seconded by **Commissioner Walston** to approve the transfer of \$36,176.39 from the **Sheriff's office funds** to Capital Outlay for the purchase of a vehicle. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Marshall and seconded by Commissioner Walston to appoint Emergency Service Commissioners for Districts #1, #2, #4, #5 and \$6. Steve Bell reported that District #3 and #7 had not been able to have a meeting. Judge Blanchette stated that hopefully the remainder of appointment could be made before the end of the year. Joe Smith was adamant that the districts needed to file their annual accountings to the court as required by law. This delinquency was going to have to stop because they were dealing with taxpayers' money. Commissioner Marshall stated he would like the districts to be made up of citizens and not just fire department members. Judge Blanchette agreed with Commissioner Marshall and reported he had received inquiries from TAC along that same line. He advised the appointments be made as presented and that next year the court will have more time to find citizens to serve on the boards. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

Steve Bell informed the court of a "Target Hardening" grant for security cameras at county facilities. Commissioner Nash motioned to approve security cameras at the county barns and collections center at a cap of \$4000 each to be paid from the emergency management grant; and security cameras at the courthouse and justice center at a maximum of \$5000 each to be paid from courthouse security funds.

Commissioner Walston seconded this motion. Commissioner Hughes ask that a cost be obtained to add the tax office. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Marshall obtained two bids to build a county barn:
Dwight Faircloth - \$58,235 and Stewart Steel Buildings - \$41,800. He motioned to accept the low bid for the construction of a **county barn** for **Precinct #3. Commissioner Hughes** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Judge Blanchette and seconded by Commissioner Hughes to appoint the following to the Tyler County Hospital board of managers:

Mary Cryer (Precinct #2) term: 2010 - 2012 Mary Lou Jeans (Precinct #4) 2010 - 2012

Robert Swearingen, M.D. (County Judge's appointment)

Commissioner Walston felt these appointments were not due at this time due to past action to have the appointments coincide with the end of the respective commissioner's term of office. A motion was made by **Commissioner Nash** and seconded by **Commissioner Marshall** to table action until Friday, December 18th to search the minutes to verify the appointments to be made. All voted yes and none no.

Judge Blanchette motioned to adopt the order setting the regular terms of Commissioners' Court meetings for the calendar year of 2010. Commissioner Marshall seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

Commissioners' Court December 14, 2009

Jimmie Cooley, president of the Chamber of Commerce, reported a great year after the reorganization of the chamber. She thanked the court for their financial support. Kathy Fetner, president-elect stated that her goals as treasurer were for the Chamber to be financially responsible. She also thanked the court for support of the Tyler County Chamber of Commerce.

A motion was made by Commissioner Nash and seconded by Commissioner Hughes that the meeting adjourn. All voted yes and none no.
