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ORDER PROHIBITING OUTDOOR BURNING

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court finds that circumstances present in all or part of the unincorporated area of the county create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Commissioners Court of Tyler County that all outdoor burning in the unincorporated area of the county for 30 days from the date of adoption of the Order, unless restrictions are terminated earlier based on a determination made by the Texas Forest Service or this Court. This Order is adopted pursuant to Local Government Code§352.081, and other applicable statutes. This Order does not prohibit outdoor burning activities related to public health and safety that are authorized by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for: (1) firefighter training; (2) public utility, natural gas pipeline or mining operations; (3) planting or harvesting of agricultural crops; or, (4) burns that are conducted by a prescribed burn manager certified under Section 153.048, Natural Resources Code, and meet the standards of Section 153.047, Natural Resources Code.

IN ACCORDANCE with Local Government Code §352.081(h), a violation of this Order is a Class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Commissioners Court of Tyler County that the County Judge is given the option to suspend the ban at his discretion should conditions justify.

ADOPTED this 10^{th} day of May, 2010 by a vote of 5 ayes and 0 nays effective the 10^{th} day of May, 2010 at 12:00 AM.

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ORDER PROHIBITING OUTDOOR BURNING

WHEREAS, the Texas Forest Service determined that conditions in Tyler County are, according to the U. S. Drought Monitor, "abnormally dry" creating a Fuel Dryness of "extremely dry;"

WHEREAS, the County Judge finds that circumstances present in all or part of the unincorporated area of the county create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the County Judge of Tyler County that all outdoor burning in the unincorporated area of the county from noon May 7, 2010 until noon May 10, 2010, unless restrictions are terminated earlier based on a determination made by the Texas Forest Service or this Court. This Order is adopted pursuant to Local Government Code§352.081, and other applicable statutes. This Order does not prohibit outdoor burning activities related to public health and safety that are authorized by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for: (1) firefighter training; (2) public utility, natural gas pipeline or mining operations; (3) planting or harvesting of agricultural crops; or, (4) burns that are conducted by a prescribed burn manager certified under Section 153.048, Natural Resources Code, and meet the standards of Section 153.047, Natural Resources Code.

IN ACCORDANCE with Local Government Code §352.081(h), a violation of this Order is a Class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00.
