City of Woodville, until the next meeting to give the voter registrar time to certify the  
number of signatures. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded the motion. All voted yes and  
none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** to approve a **joint election** with  
**Woodville ISD**. **Commissioner Walston** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none  
no.

**Commissioner Marshall** motioned to approve a **joint election** with **City of Woodville**.  
**Commissioner Walston** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Nash** to approve a **joint election** with **Warren  
ISD**. **Commissioner Hughes** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Nash** to approve a **joint election** with **Spurger ISD**. **Commissioner Walston** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

**Commissioner Walston** motioned to approve a lease/purchase for a refurbished copy machine from OCE' Better Business Machines, for the **Extension Office**, as requested by Shannon Chambers. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Hughes**. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** to adopt the resolution for Hurricane Ike Community Fuel Reduction Grant through the Texas Forest Service in the amount of \$5000. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Nash**. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED RESOLUTION

PRESENTATIONS:

Terry Riley presented the second quarter constable report. Sheriff Hennigan commended the constables for their assistance to his department.

Redistricting update: Judge Blanchette stated he has not heard back from Professor Guinn. However, Professor Guinn will not have solid numbers until January when the census reports are received. He did not contemplate any significant shifts in the population for Tyler County. Commissioner Nash added the information he received from the Tax Appraisal District showed a noteworthy amount of additional homes; therefore, he expected a greater number in population.

WorkForce office status: Employees from the Tyler County office will be reassigned to Livingston or Jasper. SEE ATTACHED

Ray Hensarling began with commiseration of the loss of local historian, Jack Whitmeyer. He reported the **Tyler County Historical Commission** had placed several historical markers at cemeteries and a church in Doucette. Their main project is the **courthouse restoration**. He reported that corporate and individual donors are willing to make contributions if the court is "committed" both mentally and financially. The last attempt to get the State grant failed by a few points, to which if Tyler County had the plans and specifications in place would have scored higher in the grant process. Mr. Hensarling estimated the cost of plans and specifications to be approximately \$900,000. He summarized his presentation with "The courthouse is the center of civic pride" in any community. Mary Nell Rainey added later that courthouse restoration in other counties have brought about "much economic benefits". Citizens had rather spend less taxes by having the State of Texas pickup some of the cost, which is expected to be around five million dollars.

Emergency Management "hurricane season" preparedness: Phil Ryan reported he had attended several seminars and training classes. He and Judge Blanchette have had several speaking engagements within the county concerning hurricane preparedness. Mr. Ryan will be seeking a grant for a new ID badge machine. He is working on getting some of the generators repaired. Mr. Ryan praised Sondra Wilson, from the Tyler County Hospital for her work in emergency management; she is well recognized at the State level. Judge Blanchette added he saw a need for a public information officer (PIO) to which he and Mr. Ryan has appointed Carly Anderson from Chester. Commissioner Nash reported the fuel depot for generators was near completion.

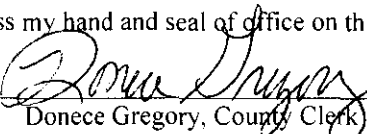
A motion was made by Commissioner Walston to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Nash seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

Reference: Lease No. 130678

This Addendum is made part of the Lease Agreement referenced above ("**Lease**") between **LEAF Funding, Inc.** ("we" "us" and "ours") and LEGGETT INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT ("you" and "your"). Capitalized terms used but not defined will have the meaning given to them in the Lease. If there is any conflict between the terms of this Addendum and the terms of the Lease, the terms of this Addendum will control and prevail.

**1. Funding Intent.** You reasonably believe that funds can be obtained sufficient to make all Lease Payments and other payments during the term of the Lease. You agree that your chief executive or administrative officer (or your administrative office that has the responsibility of preparing the budget submitted to your governing body, as applicable) will provide for funding for such payments in your annual budget request submitted to your governing body. If your governing body chooses not to appropriate funds for such payments, you agree that your governing body will evidence such nonappropriation by omitting funds for such payments due during the applicable fiscal period from the budget that it adopts. You and we agree that your obligation to make Lease Payments under the Lease will be your current expense and will not be interpreted to be a debt in violation of applicable law or constitutional limitations or requirements. Nothing contained in the Lease will be interpreted as a pledge of your general tax revenues, funds or moneys.

**2. Nonappropriation of Funds.** If (a) sufficient funds are not appropriated and budgeted by your governing body in any fiscal period for Lease Payments or other payments and (b) you have exhausted all funds legally available for such payments, due under the Lease, then you will give us written notice and the Lease will terminate as of the last day of your fiscal period for which funds for Lease Payments are available. Such termination is without any expense or penalty, except for the portions of the Lease Payments and those expenses associated with your return of the Equipment in accordance with the Lease for which funds have been budgeted or appropriated or are otherwise legally available. You agree that, to the extent permitted by law, you will not terminate the Lease if any funds are appropriated by you or to you for the acquisition or use of equipment or services performing functions similar to the Equipment during your fiscal period in which such termination would occur.

**3. Authority and Authorization.** You represent and agree that: (a) you are a state or a political subdivision or agency of a state; (b) the entering into and performance of the Lease is authorized under your state laws and Constitution and does not violate or contradict any judgment, law, order, or regulation, or cause any default under any agreement to which you are party; (c) you have complied with all bidding requirements and, where necessary, have properly presented the Lease for approval and adoption as a valid obligation on your part; and (d) you have sufficient appropriated funds or other moneys available to pay all amounts due under the Lease for your current fiscal period. Upon our request, you agree to provide us with an opinion of counsel as to clauses (a) through (d) above, an incumbency certificate, and other documents that we request, with all such documents being in a form satisfactory to us.

**4. Government Use.** You agree that (a) you will comply with all information reporting requirements of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, including but not limited to the execution and delivery to us of information statements requested by us, and (b) the use of the Equipment is essential for your proper, efficient and economic operation, you will be the only entity to use the Equipment during the term of the Lease and you will use the Equipment only for your governmental purposes. Upon our request you will provide us with an essential use letter in a form satisfactory to us as to clause (b) above.

**5. Insurance.** You agree to provide and maintain at your own expense (a) property insurance against the loss, theft, destruction of, or damage to, the Equipment for its full replacement value, naming us as loss payee, and (b) public liability and third party property insurance, naming us as an additional insured. You will give us certificates or other evidence of such insurance on the Equipment at such times as we request. All insurance obtained from a third party insurer will be in a form, amount and with companies acceptable to us, and will provide that we will be given 30 days' advance notice of any cancellation or material change of such insurance.

**6. Indemnification.** With respect to any claims, actions, or suits that are made against us as a result of your actions, omissions, negligence or willful misconduct ("Claims"), to the extent permitted by law, you agree to reimburse us for, and if we request, defend us against, any such Claims.

**7. Choice of Law.** Regardless of any conflicting provision in the Lease, **THE LEASE WILL BE GOVERNED BY THE LAWS OF THE STATE IN WHICH YOU ARE LOCATED.**

This Addendum supplements and amends the Lease only to the extent and in the manner set forth, and in all other respects, the Lease will remain in full force and effect.

**JOINT ELECTION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE  
CITY OF WOODVILLE AND THE COUNTY OF TYLER, TEXAS**

This joint election agreement is made this 9<sup>th</sup> day of Aug, 2010, by and between the **City of Woodville** (the "City") and the **County of Tyler, Texas** (the "County"). Other political subdivisions conducting elections may enter into a similar agreement with the County to participate in this joint election.

WHEREAS, the City plans to hold an election on November 2, 2010;

WHEREAS, the County plans to hold a General Election on November 2, 2010;

WHEREAS, Texas Election Code section 271.002 authorizes the governing bodies of political subdivisions to enter into an agreement to hold joint elections in election precincts that can be served by common polling places;

WHEREAS, the City and the County will hold elections on the same day; and

WHEREAS, the parties to this agreement serve voters within the same boundaries, and it would be to the benefit of the County, the City, and the citizens and voters thereof to hold the elections jointly.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED that a joint election will be held by the City and the County (and any other political subdivision approved by the County who enters into a similar joint election agreement with the County) under the following terms and conditions:

1. The notice of election and order of election for the City will be the responsibility of the City. This includes any bills that may be incurred as a result of posting and publishing these notices. The notice may be published either jointly or separately with the County.
2. The Tyler County Clerk agrees to coordinate, supervise and handle all aspects of administering the Joint Election in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code and as outlined in this Agreement. The City and each additional participating authority agrees to pay Tyler County for equipment, supplies, services and administrative costs as outlined in this agreement. The Tyler County Clerk will serve as administrator for the election; however, each participating authority remains responsible for the lawful conduct of their respective election, unless contracted with the County Clerk.
3. The City and each other participating authority will be responsible for preparation, adoption and publication of all required election orders,



resolutions, and any other pertinent documents required by their respective governing bodies. The County and each participating authority may jointly publish the required notices dictated by the Texas Election Code.

4. Each participating authority agrees that voting at the joint election will be by use of an ES&S Automark that meets the DRE requirements and optical scan voting system approved by the Secretary of State in accordance with the Texas Election Code. The Tyler County Clerk's Office will be responsible for the preparation of programs and the testing of the optical scan system.

5. The County agrees to provide ES&S Automarks, M100 Scanners and voting booths for the joint election.

6. Voting locations will be the voting locations for the county precincts as approved by Tyler County Commissioners' Court. The voting locations are listed in **Exhibit "A"** attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. In the event a voting location is not available, the Tyler County Clerk will arrange for use of an alternate location with the approval of each participating authority affected by the change. Tyler County will be responsible for submitting any polling location changes to the Department of Justice for pre-clearance that changes from the current list approved. The Tyler County Clerk will notify each participating authority of any changes from the locations listed in **Exhibit "A"**.

7. The Tyler County Commissioners' Court will appoint the Presiding Judge and alternate Presiding Judge for each polling location. The Tyler County Clerk shall arrange for the training and compensation of all Presiding Judges and clerks. If a person is unable or unwilling to serve, the Tyler County Clerk will make every effort to substitute the individual with someone of the same Party affiliation first and then whomever is available.

8. The Tyler County Clerk will arrange for all election supplies and election printing, including, but not limited to, all forms, signs and other materials used by the Election Judges at the voting locations.

9. The Tyler County Clerk will provide instructions and other information needed to enable the Election Judges to conduct a proper election.

10. A joint ballot prepared by the Tyler County Clerk will be used for conducting the joint election. Each participating authority shall furnish the Tyler County Clerk a list of candidates and/or propositions showing the order and the exact manner in which their candidate names and/or proposition(s) are to appear on the official ballot. Each participating authority will be responsible for proofreading and approving the ballot in so far as it pertains to that authority's candidates and/or propositions.

11. Donece Gregory, Tyler County Clerk, is appointed as Early Voting Clerk in compliance with Sections 271.006 of the Texas Election Code. Other deputy Early Voting judges/clerks will be appointed by the Early Voting clerk as needed to process Early Voting mail and to conduct Early Voting at the main location and branch locations.

12. Early Voting by personal appearance will be conducted at the locations and times as described in **Exhibit "B"** attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Any qualified voter for the Joint Election may vote early by personal appearance at either the main Early Voting location or at any one of the branch locations.

13. All requests for Early Voting ballots by mail that are received by participating authorities will be transported on the day of receipt to the Tyler County Clerk, Donece Gregory, 116 S. Charlton Street, Woodville, Texas 75979 for processing. Persons voting by mail will send their voted ballots to the Tyler County Clerk, 116 S. Charlton Street, Woodville, TX 75979.

14. All Early Voting ballots will be prepared for counting by an Early Voting Ballot Board appointed by the County in accordance with Section 87.001 of the Texas Election Code.

15. If the participating authority opts to conduct Early Voting for their entity, as a branch polling place: The political sub-divisions will assist in picking up the voter sign-in sheets each Early Voting day where practical and delivery to the County Clerk's office by 4:00 p.m.

16. The County Clerk will notify and bill the City for its' part of the cost for the programming and rental of the equipment, supplies, ballots, compensation of personnel, rental of the polling place and administrative cost if under contract. On Election Day, November 2, 2010, the County will secure the location and facilities where the election will be conducted.

17. The County will be responsible for preparing and running the election on November 2, 2010.

18. The City will be responsible for canvassing the election results of their election.

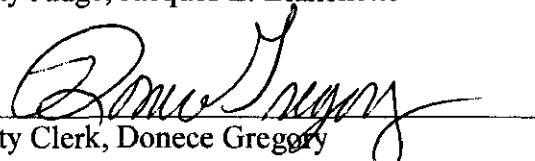

10. A joint ballot prepared by the Tyler County Clerk will be used for conducting the joint election. Each participating authority shall furnish the Tyler County Clerk a list of candidates and/or

propositions showing the order and the exact manner in which their candidate names and/or proposition(s) are to appear on the official ballot. Each participating authority will be responsible for proofreading and approving the ballot in so far as it pertains to that authority's candidates and/or propositions.

11. Donece Gregory, Tyler County Clerk, is appointed as Early Voting Clerk in compliance with Sections 271.006 of the Texas Election Code. Other deputy Early Voting judges/clerks will be appointed by the Early Voting clerk as needed to process Early Voting mail and to conduct Early Voting at the main location and branch locations.
12. Early Voting by personal appearance will be conducted at the locations and times as described in **Exhibit "B"** attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Any qualified voter for the Joint Election may vote early by personal appearance at either the main Early Voting location or at any one of the branch locations.
13. All requests for Early Voting ballots by mail that are received by participating authorities will be transported on the day of receipt to the Tyler County Clerk, Donece Gregory, 116 S. Charlton Street, Woodville, Texas 75979 for processing. Persons voting by mail will send their voted ballots to the Tyler County Clerk, 116 S. Charlton Street, Woodville, TX 75979.
14. All Early Voting ballots will be prepared for counting by an Early Voting Ballot Board appointed by the County in accordance with Section 87.001 of the Texas Election Code.
15. If the participating authority opts to conduct Early Voting for their entity: The political sub-divisions will assist in picking up the voter sign-in sheets each Early Voting day where practical and delivery to the County Clerk's office by 4:00pm.
16. The County Clerk will notify and bill the District for its' part of the cost for the programming and rental of the equipment, supplies, ballots, compensation of personnel, rental of the polling place and administrative cost if under contract. The County will secure the location and facilities where the election will be conducted.
17. The County will be responsible for preparing and running the election.

18. The DISTRICT Board of Trustees will be responsible for canvassing the election results of the school election.

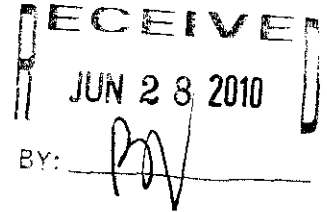

This is to officially inform you that the Board of Directors took action on June 8<sup>th</sup> to approve a staff recommendation to close the Tyler County satellite office. The reason for this action is the continuing loss of Workforce Investment Act funds that support our workforce centers and satellite offices. It was a very difficult decision to make. The last day of business is scheduled for August 20<sup>th</sup>, and we plan to vacate the facility by August 31<sup>st</sup>. If there is a change to this, I will let you know.

I'm sure you have concerns about Tyler County citizens receiving workforce services. They will be served from either the Jasper County or Polk County workforce centers. Staff from those centers will be sure that needed services are available to the Tyler County population and businesses. We are pleased that there are vacant positions within the workforce center operator's business that the three affected employees can transfer to if they wish.

You should have had a contact from our executive director Charlene Meadows. Hopefully, she was able to answer any questions you had. If not, I am available to you at 936-327-3166.

Thank you for your support and for appointing our two Board members from Tyler County. Sue Wood and Mark Tullia are active, committed members. It's a pleasure to work with them. Again, I want to assure you that Tyler County residents will have access to workforce services after the office closing, and that this decision to close was made for business reasons.

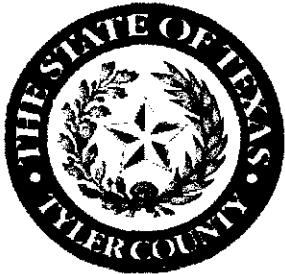
