A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** and seconded by **Commissioner Walston** to approve the **line-item transfers** for the **Juvenile Probation Department**. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED LINE ITEM TRANSFERS

The County Judge summarized the **budget** being considered for fiscal year 2011 would be supported by retaining last year's tax rate. Judge Blanchette pointed out the court has worked diligently to have a depth of understanding the fund balances at the end of this year to bring them into a "pure reconcilable position", with the help of Mrs. Skinner. Commissioner Marshall reported as per the Appraisal District, the value of his property had not increased; therefore, if the county kept the same rate as last year, taxes would not be increased unless the taxpayer's value increased.

The consideration of 2010 tax rate for the 2011 budget: Judge Blanchette reported the rate being considered was the same rate as last year. There was concern that if the court adopts the lower rate (effective tax rate) and the values drop next year the court would have to levy a much higher rate than retaining last year's rate. Commissioner Walston's observation was that the county was in much better shape financially than other counties because this court had not depended on oil and gas revenue to balance the previous budgets. No comments from other members of the court were made.

Judge Blanchette noted the Tyler County Hospital was proposing to stay with the effective tax rate; therefore, they would not have to have a public hearing and should not be part of the agenda item. A motion was made by **Commissioner Hughes** to **propose** the same **tax rate** as last year being .4433 cents for general fund and .1668 cents for Road & Bridge (County Special). This rate exceeds the effective tax rate. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded the motion. The voice vote taken was Commissioner Nash voted yes, Commissioner Hughes voted yes, Commissioner Marshall voted yes, Commissioner Walston voted yes and Judge Blanchette also voted yes.

Commissioner Walston motioned to set the first **public hearing**, on the proposed rate, for September 16th at 10:00 a.m. The second public hearing will be September 20th at 10:00 a.m. The adoption of a tax rate will be at a meeting on September 27th at 10:00 a.m. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Nash.** All voted yes and none no.

Clerk's Notation: Due to a conflict in a previous scheduled court being held of September 20^{th} in the district courtroom, an alternate date of September 22^{nd} was identified after a telephone poll was taken of the commissioners after the meeting. The public notice to be published will reflect the change in the date of the public hearings.

A motion was made by Commissioner Walston to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Nash seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.
