# TYLER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT SPECIAL MEETING September 27, 2010 ---- 8:30 a.m.

THE STATE OF TEXAS ON THIS THE 27th day of September, 2010 the Commissioners' Court in and for Tyler County, Texas convened in a Special Meeting at the Commissioners' Courtroom in Woodville, Texas, the following members of the Court were present, to wit:

A motion was made by **Commissioner Walston** to adopt the **Budget for Fiscal Year 2011** for Tyler County. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded the motion. All voted yes with exception of Commissioner Nash voting no. SEE ATTACHED BUDGET

Judge Blanchette explained the court had held two public hearings as required by law; and, the court proposes the same tax rate as adopted last year. He then read aloud the proposed tax rate. Commissioner Marshall motioned to adopt the order setting the 2010 tax rate. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Walston. Commissioner Nash questioned whether the motion was for all three rates since one may be opposed to one of the rates but "good" with two of the rates. The motion was for all rates: a tax rate of .4433 for the County General Fund; .1668 for County Special (Road & Bridge); and, to adopt a tax rate of .1369 for the Tyler County Hospital. All voted yes with exception of Commissioner Nash voting no. SEE ATTACHED ORDER

Judge Blanchette reported the representative from Patillo, Brown & Hill could not attend this meeting, but requested presentation of the **2009 Audit** at the meeting in October. He further reported he had read the entire audit. The Judge and Jackie Skinner will meet at 2:00 p.m. concerning some spelling corrections and forward them to the audit firm. No action was taken.

Judge Blanchette explained the court's interest in appointing an investment committee that will serve in a different capacity from the advisory committee. Commissioner Nash proposed the committee be made up of a representative from the court, county treasurer and county auditor and a representative from the criminal district attorney's office. He stated the committee needs to bring a plan to the court setting up a schedule with the following recommendations:

- How much money to have available
- What type of investments to make for a periodic time so the county will have access to "x" number of dollars
- The committee can make investments by a due date

Judge Blanchette added the audit report recommended the county look into making investments within the statutes in a time frame so they can be rotated. Commissioner Nash commented the county has 11 million dollars that is not in any kind of investment and should never have more than two or three million dollars available at any one time. A motion was made by Commissioner Walston to appoint an Investment Committee and authorize them to make investments on behalf of the county. The members of the committee will be Commissioner Nash, County Treasurer, County Auditor, County Judge and a representative of the Criminal District Attorney's office. Commissioner Marshall seconded the motion. The committee is charged to report to the court at the November regular meeting with a game plan. Mrs. Fuller asked about having a representative from the community. Judge Blanchette responded this is an internal

directive for the benefit of the county treasurer to give her instructions on where to place the money and move forward with investing the funds. All voted yes and none no.

The County Clerk presented a comparison with surrounding counties of fees charged by the sheriff and constables. She stated this was not a list of every fee. Mrs. Gregory reminded the court of the discussion in the budget workshops concerning the constable's increase in car allowance. She recommended the citations and other documents served by the Constables increase by at least \$5. After much discussion with JP#1 Weatherford, Sheriff Hennigan and the County Clerk, Commissioner Marshall motioned to set the fees as follows:
