RESCINDING ORDER


Commissioner Walston motioned the meeting adjourned. Commissioner Nash seconded

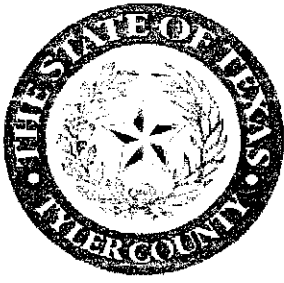
Per John Fuller with TAC Legal:

A **BURN BAN** action requires either an “Order Prohibiting Outdoor Burning” (to put into effect) or “Rescinding Order ...” (to take out of effect)

All Orders relative to Outdoor Burning must:

- *Be adopted in a legally posted Commissioners Court (cannot be done by or delegated to the County Judge)*
- *Have fire danger status documentation to back order*
- *Have fire danger status documentation attached to the Order which is filed with the County Clerk.*

There is no statute or legal protocol for temporarily suspending a burn ban.



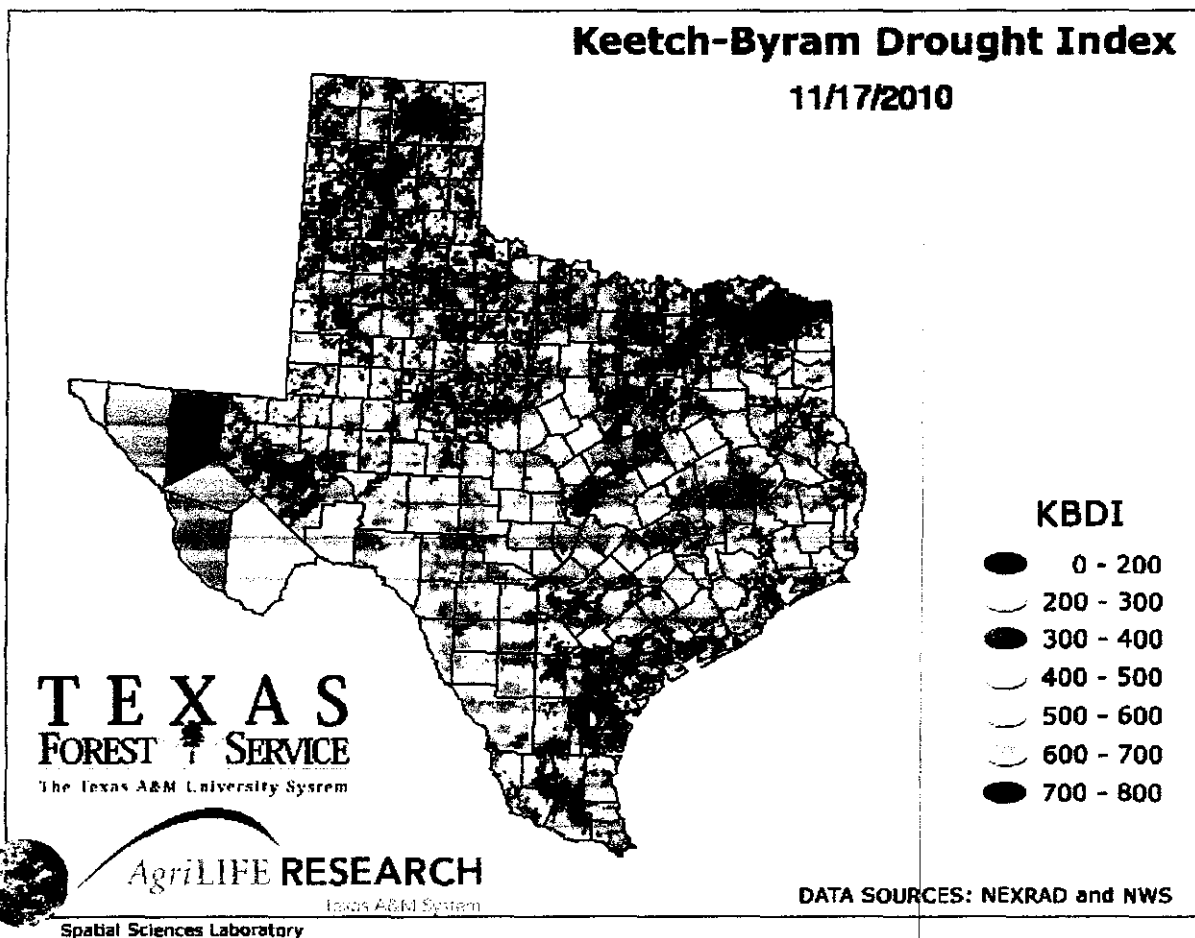


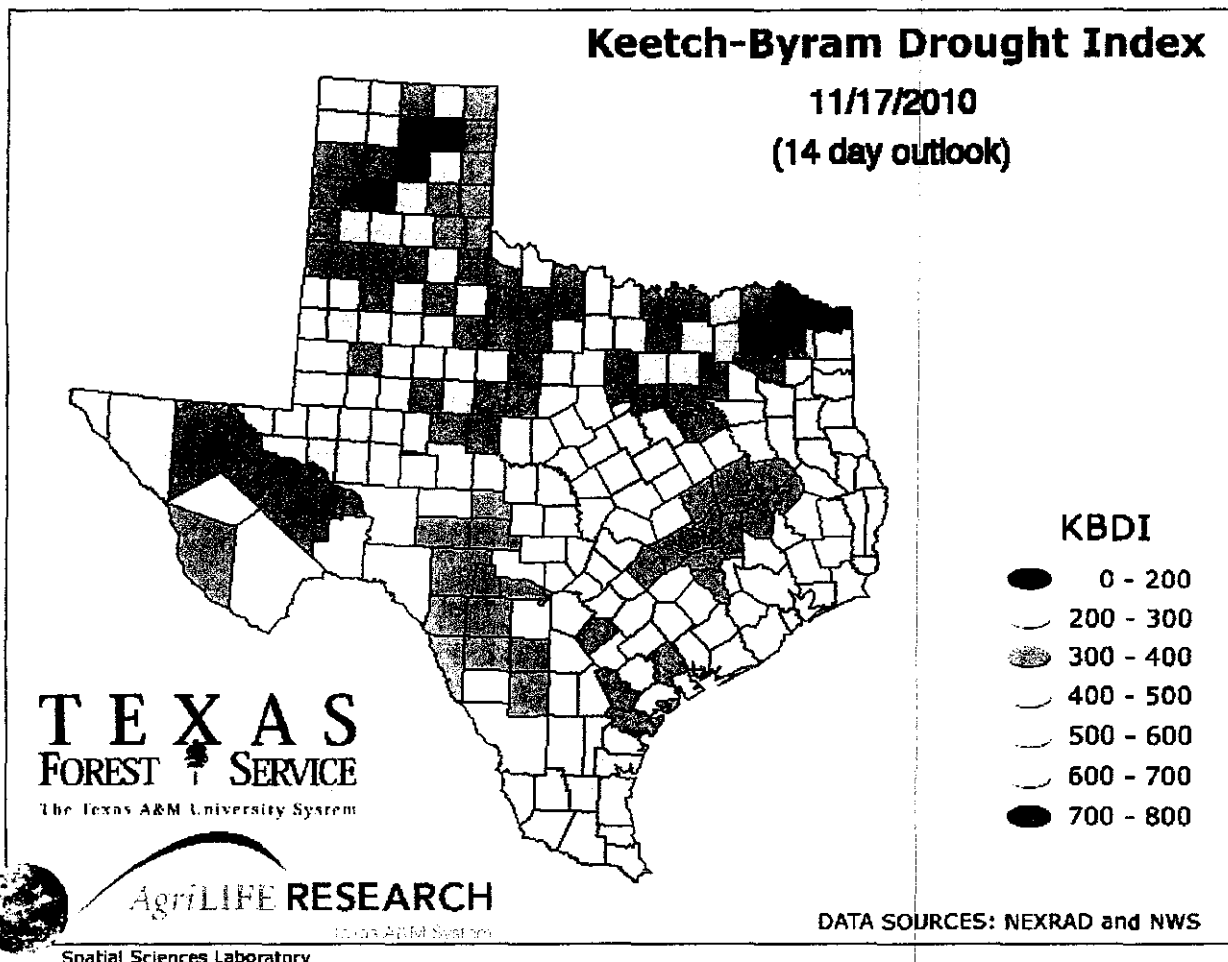
