# TYLER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT SPECIAL MEETING December 27, 2010 ---- 8:30 a.m.

THE STATE OF TEXAS ON THIS THE 27th day of December, 2010 the Commissioners' Court in and for Tyler County, Texas convened in a Special Meeting at the Commissioners' Courtroom in Woodville, Texas, the following members of the Court present, to wit:

Judge Blanchette motioned to approve the line item transfers/budget amendments as presented by the County Auditor for Collection Center, District Clerk, Nutrition Center, Road & Bridge #1, Road & Bridge #2, Road & Bridge #3, Extension Department, Constable Pct. #1, District Attorney, Justice of Peace #4, Veterans Services, County Clerk, County Court, County Judge, Data Processing, and Building Maintenance. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Walston. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

The County Treasurer requested her new employee to be deputized in order that she can get a letter to the bank. A motion was made by Commissioner Hughes to approve the deputation of Sally Wallace as a deputy assistant to the County Treasurer. Commissioner Marshall seconded this motion. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Marshall motioned to re-appoint Commissioners Phillip Darsey and Tobi Russell to Emergency Services Districts #7. Commissioner Walston sec and d the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED LIST

Judge Blanchette explained the court has tried to align appointments of hospital board members with the terms of the commissioners and judge. However, it is not possible because they are required to be two year terms per law and it does not line up. The terms will be staggered; however, there will be an overlap on three positions. There will be an overlap of one year. The County Judge's position has been to make two appointments. He was concerned this puts an unfair position by one member of the court onto the hospital board of managers. He will make a recommendation at the January meeting to arrend to those two slots and allow it to be one appointed slot of an at-large position. Commissioner Walston motioned to re-appoint Mary Cryer and Mary Lou Jeans to a one year term ending December 31, 2011, amending previous action. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hughes. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED A motion was made by **Commissioner Nash** to re-appoint George Standley and Robert Allison, Jr. to a two year term ending December 31, 2012. The motion as seconded by Commissioner Marshall. All voted yes and none no. Judge Blanchette motioned to table appointment or reappointment of the two positions that has historically been identified with the County Judge's responsibility until the January 14th meeting. Commissioner Hughes seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

Judge Blanchette updated the court with communication he received from Karen Stafford, representative of the Texas Forest Service. He felt the conditions should be reviewed on a day to day basis. Commissioner Walston was concerned that Tyler County was not included in the Governor's disaster declaration which would mean farmers and

ranchers in our area would not receive federal funding assistance. Audrey reported the county did not meet the criteria of the indicators used by the state, but may meet it by January. Judge Blanchette also clarified a burn ban did not ban burning of household garbage as long as it was in a covered container. No action was taken.

The power point presentation was not made because all the commissioners, with exception of Commissioner Marshall had already seen it. A motion was made by **Judge Blanchette** to seek the Texas Safe Shelter Initiative Grant for an up to 5000 sq.ft. sheltering facility, mainly for the purpose of 211 designated evacuees. **Commissioner Walston** seconded the motion. This facility will be able to withstand 200 mile an hour winds. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Nash motioned the meeting adjourned. Commissioner Marshall seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS, THE MEETING ADJOURNED: 9:00 a.m.

#### **HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE CHAPTER 263 COUNTY HOSPITALS**

SUBCHAPTER C. BOARD OF MANAGERS

Sec. 263.041 APPOINTMENT OF BOARD OF MANAGERS

- (a) The commissioners court of a county shall appoint at least six but not more than 12 residents of the county as the board of managers of a county hospital...
- (b) A manager is appointed for a term of two years ... one-half of the managers' terms expire each year.
- (c) An appointment to fill a vacancy is for the unexpired term.
- (d) A vacancy is created if a manager misses three consecutive board meetings unless the board takes formal action to excuse the absences.
