No action was taken on line item transfers/budget amendments.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** and seconded by **Commissioner Nash**
to advertise for bids for **petroleum products**. Commissioner Walston suggested
changing the specifications on the invitation to bids. Bids will be opened on Friday, May
13th. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Marshall motioned to authorize **security shredding** at a date in May for
all departments at a cost of .17 cents per pound. The motion was seconded by
Commissioner Walston. All voted yes and none no.

Judge Blanchette recommended the order prohibiting outdoor burning not be rescinded.
The county is facing wildfire in the Triple D Ranch area.

Joe Smith expressed his concern over the cost, in light of the cost already incurred, of
healthcare services of a capitol murder suspect that is now in "Vernon". The trial is
anticipated to be June 19th. Sheriff Hennigan reported the suspect will likely be moved
from Vernon to a nursing home in Fort Worth. A motion was made by **Commissioner
Marshall** to adopt a resolution, if a medical personal recognizance bond is not set by
Judge Stover, authorizing Judge Blanchette to send a letter to the Attorney General on
behalf of the commissioners' court requesting a conditional personal recognizance bond
on the murder suspect; that he be placed in a nursing home with a GPS tracking ankle
band, to alleviate additional expense to the county. **Commissioner Nash** seconded the
motion. All voted yes and none no.


Commissioner Marshall made a motion to adjourn. **Commissioner Nash** seconded the
