A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** to adopt a resolution, if a medical personal recognizance bond is not set by Judge Stover, authorizing Judge Blanchette to send a letter to the Attorney General on behalf of the commissioners' court requesting a conditional personal recognizance bond on the murder suspect; that he be placed in a nursing home with a GPS tracking ankle band, to alleviate additional expense to the county. **Commissioner Nash** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Marshall made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Nash seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.
