Morgan Wright delivered the invocation and then Commissioner Hughes led the pledge of allegiance to the American flag.

A motion was made by Commissioner Walston and seconded by Commissioner Marshall to approve the minutes of February 17, 2012 but March 5, 2012 was tabled until ratification of these items in this meeting. All voted yes and none no. March 5th minutes will be put on next agenda.

A motion was made by Commissioner Nash and seconded by Commissioner Walston to approve the consent agenda: monthly reports of probation departments, JP# 1, county clerk, county extension and county auditor; and, table report from county treasurer All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by Commissioner Walston and seconded by Commissioner Marshall to approve the allowances and accounts payable as presented by the County Auditor. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

Budget Amendments and Line Item Transfers were not presented by the County Auditor.

Commissioner Walston motioned to open bids for Petroleum Products. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hughes. All voted yes and none no. Bids were received from Suncoast Resources and Gardner Oil. SEE ATTACHED BIDS.

Commissioner Nash motioned to open bids for Road Materials. Commissioner Hughes seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. Bids were received from:

Bryan & Bryan Thomas Supply Seabreeze Culvert, Inc. Rural Pipe & Supply Conroe Wood Products Lufkin Creosoting Co.

East Texas Asphalt Matthews Construction Big 4, Inc.

Lou Cloy presented proposals for three desks and credenzas for the office of Criminal District Attorney. One proposal would cost \$3500 to \$4000, but furniture was made of particle board. The other proposal would cost \$6900. This furniture was made of wood and would be assembled by staff from Gib Lewis prison unit. Commissioner Marshall motioned to approve the purchase of furniture made by the Gib Lew prison unit, to be paid from Office Equipment line item of the general fund. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hughes. All voted yes and none no.

No action was taken on the proclamation for Child Abuse Prevention Month. This will be on the April agenda.

Judge Blanchette motioned to approve the Inter-local Cooperation Agreement between the Jasper County Sheriff's office, County of Jasper and Tyler County Sheriff's office, County of Tyler. Commissioner Marshall seconded the motion. Sheriff Hennigan stated Jasper County will still make three transports a week. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by Commissioner Nash and seconded by Commissioner Walston to approve a Memorandum of Agreement with Tyler County Search and Rescue Organization, as previously reviewed by Joe Smith. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

Commissioner Nash reported \$128,000 of non committed funds from the **Ike Round II grant.** He proposed to spend a portion of the funds for additional remodeling work on the Tyler County **Nutrition Center**: finishing a wall and installing ceiling. This would provide a meeting room. Commissioner Nash reported David Waxman, grant administrator, recommends maintaining a contingency fund. **Commissioner Marshall** stated one of his projects had been left off and motioned to table this matter until the next meeting with Mr. Waxman present. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Walston**. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Nash and seconded by Commissioner Marshall to approve the donation and transfer of title of 1980 Chevy one ton pickup, serial #CCV33AV147503 from Road & Bridge, Pct. #1 to Warren Fire Department. Commissioner Nash added the County has an inter-local agreement with the fire department. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Hughes** and seconded by **Commissioner Nash** to approve a permit to Springfield Gas Pipeline to cross **County Road 1030.** All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED PERMIT

Commissioner Marshall motioned to approve the transfer of sale from Jerry Wilson's lease agreement on **Hanger #3** at the **Tyler County Airport** to John Grench. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Hughes.** All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Marshall motioned to approve the transfer of the 2004 Ford Van used by Veteran's Service, to the Tyler County Sheriff's office. Commissioner Hughes seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Walston** and seconded by **Commissioner Marshall** to approve disposal of **metal and white goods** at the Collection Center from Marsh 12, 2012 to April 12, 2012, at no cost to the residents of Tyler County. All voted yes and none no.

Judge Blanchette motioned to appoint Francine Frazier to the at-large position of the Tyler County Hospital Board, for the term March 12, 2012 to December 31, 2013. Commissioner Hughes seconded the motion. Judge Blanchette explained that she was not a registered voter when she was appointed previously. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Judge Blanchette** to approve the second amendment to the **Tax Abatement Contract** between the county and German Pellets Texas. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded the motion. 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

INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT

The Jasper County Sheriff's Office, County of Jasper, Texas hereafter referred to as "Jasper" and the Tyler County Sheriff's Office, County of Tyler, located in Woodville, Texas hereafter referred to as "Tyler County" enters into the following agreement concerning the incarceration of prisoners of the Tyler County Sheriff's Office and said agreement is set out in full hereafter.

- 1. Jasper hereby agrees to house prisoners incarcerated by Tyler County if space is available. The availability of the space shall be determined by the Jasper County Sheriff in accordance with current jail regulations as set out by Texas Commission on Jail Standards concerning the separation and categories of prisoners.
- 2. Jasper shall assess a fee for housing said prisoners at the rate of \$40.00 per day per prisoner, and Jasper shall bill Tyler County for said cost in an itemized statement showing the number of days each individual prisoner housed by Jasper. The day the inmate is booked in will be charged. The day the inmate is booked out will not be charged.
- 3. Tyler County shall pay for any and all hospital, health care services and prescription drugs provided to any prisoners housed by Jasper for Tyler County.
- 4. Tyler County hereby agrees to comply with all booking procedures of Jasper.
- 5. Jasper and Tyler County hereby agree that Jasper will not house any injured prisoners unless Tyler County has furnished an acceptable medical release signed by medical personnel, certifying that the prisoner may be incarcerated.

- 6. Jasper further agrees that should a prisoner be injured while being housed by Jasper, that Jasper will within ten (10) hours notify Tyler County of said injury and provide Tyler County with copies of all incident reports relating to said injury.
- 7. The Jasper County Sheriff reserves the right to refuse or remove any inmate from the Jasper County Jail if it is in the best interest of Jasper County. Tyler County shall promptly arrange to take custody of its prisoners if so requested by the Jasper County Sheriff.
- 8. Tyler County agrees to assume responsibility for all transportation of Tyler County prisoners housed in Jasper County Jail.
- 9. Tyler County shall be fully responsible and liable for all suits, claims, damages, losses, or expenses, including reasonable attorney's services and duties herein stated, but only in regard to transfer of prisoners by Tyler County and duties herein assigned to Tyler County, and specifically excluding the actual incarceration of prisoners by Jasper. Tyler County retains full liability for each inmate until that inmate has been processed and booked into into the Jasper County Jail.
- 10. Jasper shall be fully responsible and liable for all suits, claims, damages, losses, and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of Jasper performance or nonperformance of the services and duties herein stated, but only in regard to the actual holding and incarceration of prisoners by Jasper County Jail and specifically excluding the transfer of prisoners to and from Jasper unless transported by Jasper.
- 11. All agreements between the parties are set out in this agreement and no oral agreement not contained herein shall be enforceable against either party. Any disputes concerning this contract shall first be submitted to a mediator mutually agreed upon by both parties. If the parties fail to agree on a mediator or, if having mediated the dispute, either party is dissatisfied with the result,

and a lawsuit is filed, said lawsuit shall be filed in Jasper County, Texas, where exclusive venue lies.

12. The primary term of this agreement is for a period of one (1) year from the date of execution of this agreement by both parties.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is hereby made by and between the County of Tyler, Texas, hereinafter (in this document) referred to as Tyler County and the Tyler County Search and Rescue Organization (TC S&R) serving in Tyler County.

Tyler County, by way of the Tyler County Emergency Management Department, has ownership and possession of a manufactured travel trailer. This travel trailer has been altered and internally refabricated to serve the purpose as a mobile incident command center. This travel trailer is in need of being outfitted with a generator, communications equipment, and other resources necessary to meet the needs as a mobile incident command center for any and all emergency service providers that provide emergency services in Tyler County.

The Tyler County Search and Rescue Organization has volunteer manpower capable of, designing, outfitting, manning, and maintaining a mobile incident command center. The Tyler County Search and Rescue Organization have trucks capable of transporting the mobile incident command center from location to location.

It is agreed and understood that Tyler County will retain ownership of this travel trailer, and will maintain vehicle registration on the travel trailer. Tyler County will turn over immediate possession of the travel trailer to the Tyler County Search and Rescue Organization. The Tyler County Search and Rescue Organization will repair, install equipment, and further fabricate the travel trailer as necessary to transform it into a usable and working mobile incident command center. The travel trailer will remain in the possession of the Tyler County Search and Rescue Organization who will maintain it in an appropriate condition to be standby ready for use.



Tyler County, through the Tyler county Emergency Management Department, will provide the equipment, materials, and finances to establish this incident command center into a usable and viable emergency services resource. Equipment on hand will be used first, but any expenditure of funds beyond that will be submitted first as a request to the Tyler County Emergency Management Coordinator for approval prior to making the purchase or incurring the expense.

The Mobile Incident Command Center will be ready and available for use by all Emergency Service Providers inside Tyler County and outside Tyler County as far as Tyler County's mutual aid obligations exist. Tyler County Search and Rescue Organization will be responsible for transporting and setting up the mobile incident command center at an emergency location as the need arises. The Tyler County Search and Rescue Organization will stand by offering support and assistance to the emergency service, law enforcement, or other entity that is in charge of the incident to the extent that it is needed by that entity. On completion and closure of this mobile incident command center, Tyler County Search and Rescue Organization will be responsible for retrieving the mobile incident command center, cleaning and refitting it to be ready for the next use.

Either party, Tyler County or Tyler County Search and Rescue Organization may end this agreement by submitting a written notice thirty days prior to the date the agreement is to end. On ending this agreement, Tyler County Search and Rescue Organization will return possession of the mobile incident command center to Tyler County Emergency Management Department.

PERMIT FOR GAS PIPELINE BENEATH COUNTY ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY

I.

. . .

Springfield Pipeline Company, LLC, ("Springfield") whose principal business address is 1201 Lake Robbins Drive, The Woodlands, Texas 77380, does hereby apply for a permit as hereinafter provided to utilize and cross beneath Tyler County Road 1030 ("CR 1030"), collectively referred to as "county road".

II.

Springfield is a natural gas utility under the Texas Utilities Code § 121.000, *et seq* and is a gatherer, transporter and purchaser of natural gas produced by various wells, including but not limited to the Anadarko Well, in Tyler County, Texas situated in the E.L. Jennings Survey, Abstract No. 405.

Ш.

Springfield will construct, operate and maintain a pipeline, not greater than twelve inches (12") in diameter, to transport natural gas produced from the Anadarko well. Said pipeline will cross ("CR 1030") ("0.37 miles southwest of the intersection of CR 1020 and CR 1030.")

IV.

Springfield will construct, operate and maintain the pipeline in a good and workman-like manner, in compliance with ordinary care in the pipeline industry and in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

V.

Springfield will construct the pipeline using ordinary care across the rights-of-way for ("CR 1030") to a depth of up to ten feet (10'), but not less than six feet (6') below the crest of the county road. Springfield will restore the surface of the county road to the same or better condition than

its current condition.

VI.

Springfield hereby indemnifies and agrees to hold Tyler County and its officials harmless from any and all claims for personal injury (including death), damage to equipment, supplies or personal property or other claims which arise from Springfield's negligent use of the ("CR 1030") rights-of-way.

VII.

It is agreed that for the consideration stated in this permit, including indemnifying Tyler

County and burying the pipeline up to ten feet, but not less than six feet below the crest of ("CR

1030"), Springfield shall not be required by Tyler County, the Commissioners' Court of Tyler

County or the Tyler County Judge to remove the pipeline crossing ("CR 1030"). However,

Springfield shall be required to relocate said pipeline only if doing so becomes necessary due to

a bona fide public emergency. The relocation shall be within Springfield's thirty-foot rights-of-

way beneath ("CR 1030"). Tyler County, the Commissioners' Court of Tyler County and/or the

Tyler County Judge shall not require Springfield to relocate the pipeline except for public

emergencies, including, but not limited to allowing widening or other changing of any traffic

lane. Springfield will remove and relocate the gathering line at its sole cost and expense upon

ninety (90) days written notification by Tyler County.

Tyler County makes no warranty of title or representation of its right to use the rights-of-way

for ("CR 1030").

IX.

Springfield and the Commissioners' Court of Tyler County, Texas agree that use of the right-
