Action was not taken in Executive Session or due to Executive Session.


Commissioner Marshall motioned the meeting adjourned. Commissioner Walston seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

Chambers County Finds Texas-Size Speed is Easy with Imation InfiniVault™ Active Archive Storage Appliance

Chambers County, Texas is one of the fastest growing counties in the nation, its population (currently around 35,000) expanding by 36 percent over the last ten years. The county's IT division serves a broad range of government departments, including Law Enforcement, the District and County Attorney, Treasurer's Office, County Auditors, the County Judge, District Judges, all Justices of the Peace and Constables, Roads & Bridges, Parks Department, Maintenance Department and the Commissioner's Court.

THE SITUATION

"Chambers County is not very big, at least by Texas standards," chuckles Mike Kubik, the county's Director of Communications. "But our IT department is responsible for storing an enormous number of images of legal documents that are filed in the County and District Clerk's Office. Those images cover all manner of legal things—deeds, property transfers, any kind of instrument that has to be recorded in court, legal filings made against a defendant, or when you have lawsuits, those types of things. All that has to be stored permanently."

"In the old days, you had to have a paper document that you could make a copy of, a certified copy, to give to somebody," continues Kubik. "But now we scan the documents in, and we're authorized to make copies of them, print them out and provide them to people who need them."

Kubik and his IT team had been relying on a familiar optical jukebox storage appliance. While they had always harbored some concerns about the long-term durability of optical media, they were now becoming increasingly frustrated by the hardware's limitations.

NEED FOR SPEED

As Kubik recalls, "Our main problem was just in the speed of retrieval, because you're talking about multiple discs that need a robotic arm to swap them out. If you've got 24 discs and you look for an image, it could be on any one of the 24. The machine had to go out and find the disc that the image was on, insert the disc in the drive, pull it up, take a look at it, and provide that information."

"By itself, one of those retrievals didn't take that long. But if you're doing 100 of those a day and it takes 30 seconds, you're wasting time."

Were there any other drawbacks? Kubik drily responds, "Well, the fact that it's a mechanical device means it will break...and it broke, more than once. It's a very finely calibrated instrument; if you know anything about robotics, it has to be. If you're off by a centimeter, well, you might as well be sticking the disc in the trash. If you're off by a millimeter, it may not cause a problem at first but eventually the mechanical devices wear out. The drives, the arms in particular, will fail."

MAKING THE SWITCH TO INFINIVault

Clearly it was time for a change, all the more so because things were starting to get even busier. Explains Kubik, "One of the things that causes a lot more activity in our County Clerk's office is the oil business. It's booming right now, so there's a whole lot of property deed searches going on."

Kubik and his team discussed their needs with the county's application vendor, NET Data, who recommended the Imation InfiniVault Active Archive Storage Appliance. Were there any other solutions that you seriously considered? "Not really," explains Kubik. "We could see that choosing the InfiniVault was a no-brainer, based on the equivalent costs and capabilities of the competing products; in other words, what we got for what we were paying."

Now that it's deployed, has the InfiniVault appliance lived up to his expectations? Kubik speaks enthusiastically: "The big advantage we've found so far is speed. It's almost an immediate response when you're searching for an image. Back when we had the optical jukebox, if you had 10 people looking for different instruments that machine was constantly searching those disks...it was slow. Now, it's near instantaneous. You can have a bunch of people looking at images all at the same time, and as far as they're concerned there's virtually no delay."

BIG RESULTS WITH SMALL STAFF

Just how many users does the Chambers County IT division support? "Including the Courthouse, we have 13 offices that are connected via our LAN and our wide area network," notes Kubik. "The WAN runs about 25 miles across, connecting via microwave and T1 approximately 200 users in those various offices."

The IT staff size required to serve those users is remarkably modest. As Kubik explains, "There are actually four of us that work here, but only two of us who have much to do with storage issues. We wear different hats; I'm also in charge of communications. One of my guys is the radio technician, he handles a lot of radio and telephone stuff. He doesn't do much IT stuff, but he can change the InfiniVault's RDX cartridges. It's not rocket science, it's pretty simple."

The InfiniVault's ease of use has made quite an impression on Kubik: "There's not a whole lot to do. Seriously, that's the advantage. Once it's configured and set up, I don't have to think about it. On my Outlook calendar, I have "Change cartridge" on every Wednesday. So that's about it. That's what I like about it," laughs Kubik. "I don't have to do much."

MORE CAPABILITY, MORE PROTECTION

But that ease of use hasn't come at the cost of functionality. Kubik explains that, because they've linked the InfiniVault to the NET Data application his department uses, they can now give users more capability than ever before. "Often someone will go to the database and search for a particular document; if they find it in the index they may want to retrieve it in order to make a copy of it."

"But sometimes they may need to add to a document. They've got a filing and there's been a modification to an order or something similar; they can't change the original order, they have to just add another page or another instrument to it. With our InfiniVault/NET Data system it's easy to just go in and attach that instrument to the same case number."

And the InfiniVault has enabled Kubik to easily deliver the multiple, redundant storage copies that are at the core of data protection best practices. "We keep an RDX copy online, and we have an RDX copy that we swap out once a week," elaborates Kubik. "We're lucky, we have an office a block away that is a former bank, and it still has a walk-in vault that we store the RDX cartridge in."

"So every Wednesday, we take one of the RDX cartridges out and carry it over there to the old bank building, and bring the other one back and reinsert it, so we've always got the duplicate backup offsite. That way I have the actual data that's stored, a copy that's current with that storage, and then another one that's a week behind. So weekly, I just swap out the backup."

CONCLUSION

Review of Texas Electronic Records Standards and Procedures, Local Government Bulletin B

REVIEW OF TEXAS ELECTRONIC RECORDS STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES, LOCAL GOVERNMENT BULLETIN B

LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE CHAPTER 205 (ELECTRONIC STORAGE OF RECORDS); TEXAS ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, TITLE 13, CHAPTER 7 (ELECTRONIC RECORDS STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES)

OVERVIEW

Local Government Bulletin B contains amendments to the Local Government Records Act of 1989, and includes regulations contained in Local Government Code Chapter 205, Electronic Storage of Records; Local Government Bulletin B also includes regulations contained in Texas Administrative Code, Title 13, Chapter 7, Electronic Records Standards and Procedures.

These regulations create statewide standards for the purpose of storing and recording permanent and non-permanent local government record data on electronic media. This document describes how Imation InfiniVault™ Active Archive Storage Appliance enables organizations to satisfy these regulations.

REGULATIONS

Sections 205.001 through 205.009 of Local Government Code Chapter 205 describe a framework for the electronic storage of local government record data as adopted by the Texas State Library and Archives Commission; these sections do not contain specific requirements for the storage equipment used in the electronic record system.

Sections 7.71 through 7.79 of Texas Administrative Code, Title 13, Chapter 7 establish the minimum requirements for the maintenance, use, retention, and storage of any electronic record of a local government whose retention period is 10 years or more on a records retention schedule adopted under Section 7.125 of this title (relating to Records Retention Schedules). These sections do not apply to electronic records with retention periods of less than 10 years, but they are subject to the applicable provisions of Local Government Code Chapter 205.

Sections 7.75 (Security of Electronic Records) and 7.77 (Retention of Electronic Records) contain specific requirements for the storage equipment used in the electronic record system.

The follow analysis discusses Section 7.75 and Section 7.77 of Texas Administrative Code, Title 13, Chapter 7 and the related features (denoted by italics) of the Imation InfiniVault.

TEXAS ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, TITLE 13, CHAPTER 7 COMPLIANCE

Section 7.75. Security of Electronic Records

Local governments must implement and maintain an electronic records security program for office and storage areas that:

- *Ensures that only authorized personnel have access to electronic records;*

InfiniVault requires that authentication be established to allow authorized access to information contained within the InfiniVault archive. Passwords are required for identification and for access to administrative functions; access to the InfiniVault will be timed-out due to inactivity.

• Provides for backup and recovery of records to protect against information loss;

InfiniVault automatically makes up to four protected copies that are uniquely serialized, and which may be removed for storage at remote locations. The records archived in InfiniVault are accessible from the file information area, online removable disks, or offline removable disks.

• Ensures that personnel are trained to safeguard confidential electronic records;

The centralized, intuitive controls in the InfiniVault management console simplify storage administration, enabling personnel to easily setup and operate an electronic records repository that safeguards confidential data with a variety of security features (WORM, encryption, password protection, etc.).

• Minimizes the risk of unauthorized alteration or erasure of electronic records;

InfiniVault stores electronic records WORM (Write Once Read Many) mode on the RDX® removable disk cartridges. The hardware-enforced WORM on these cartridges ensures that data cannot be altered or deleted until the retention period has expired.

• Documents that similar kinds of records generated and stored electronically are created by the same processes each time and have a standardized retrieval approach.

InfiniVault enables standardized storage processes based on policies specified by the administrator. This ensures fast, consistent retrieval of records at any time during their retention periods.

This section also requires that:

• A duplicate copy of essential records and any software or documentation required to retrieve and read the records must be maintained in a storage area located in a separate building from the building where the records that have been copied are maintained.

InfiniVault automatically makes protected copies that are uniquely serialized, and which may be removed for storage at remote locations. Two copies are made by default, but up to four copies may be created.

• For records stored on rewritable electronic media, the system must ensure that read/write privileges are controlled and that an audit trail of rewrites is maintained.

InfiniVault requires that authentication be established to allow authorized access to information contained within the InfiniVault archive. Passwords are required for identification and for access to administrative functions. InfiniVault also keeps an audit trail log of every action taken on a file. The audit trail includes information about the ingestion, every access subsequent, the disk cartridges and locations where the file resides, and the retention period and actions performed.


Section 7.77. Retention of Electronic Records

Local governments must establish policies and procedures to ensure that electronic records and any software, hardware, and/or documentation, including maintenance documentation, required to retrieve and read the electronic records are retained as long as the approved retention period for the electronic records.

The retention procedures must include provisions for:

• Scheduling the disposition of all electronic records, according to statutory requirements, as well as related software, documentation, and indexes;

Ingested files are put into independent archives within InfiniVault; within the archives, multiple folders may be configured. Each folder within an archive has a retention period setting, which can be configured to meet specific statutory requirements. Files will be retained until that retention period expires. In addition to the availability of the records for access, a complete inventory of all files and their locations is maintained; this index may be viewed or retrieved at any time by authorized users.

- 
- **Establishing procedures for regular recopying, reformatting, and other necessary maintenance to ensure the retention and usability of electronic records until the expiration of their retention periods.** InfiniVault maintains a table that shows the sequential order of recording onto removable cartridges, and a record of the date and time that the information was written. Any damaged or lost records on a disk cartridge may be recovered from any of duplicate (mirrored) cartridges that were created. A vault may be defined to automatically create up to three additional copies.

A hash algorithm is performed on the data to create a unique content address that is used to verify that no data has been changed during any transmission or storage operation.

CONCLUSION

By meeting a broad variety of requirements for the electronic storage of local government record data, Imation InfiniVault™ Active Archive Storage Appliance helps government organizations to comply with sections 7.75 and 7.77 of Texas Administrative Code, Title 13, Chapter 7.

PREMISES USE POLICY

1.0 POLICY BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVE

The adoption of this policy is intended to clarify and memorialize Tyler County's traditional approach to allowing individuals or groups to assemble on County owned property and to clearly state the procedures and guidelines to be followed by individuals or groups seeking the use of County owned property. Tyler County has a vested interest in allowing the use of County owned property from time to time. Some of the considerations given in drafting this policy include:

- 1.1 The importance of county government property being accessible to the community;
- 1.2 The development of positive perceptions about local county government within Tyler County, Texas;
- 1.3 Preserving the historical relationship that the local government of Tyler County, Texas has had with the community;
- 1.4 Preserving the community values of Tyler County, Texas;
- 1.5 Providing festive and seasonal decorations which are pleasant for not only members of our community, but invite and welcome visitors to Tyler County, Texas;
- 1.6 Ensuring the safety of the community; and
- 1.7 Proving clarity to the public on Tyler County's policies and procedures on the use of County property and the placement of displays on County property.

2.0 POLICY ON ASSEMBLY OR DEMONSTRATIONS ON COUNTY PROPERTY

- 2.1 This policy applies to all County Owned property and premises with the exception of the Tyler County Hospital which is governed and controlled by the policies, procedures, and authority of the Tyler County Hospital Board of Managers.
 - 2.2 Information and/or applications for use of County owned premises for assembly of groups may be obtained from the Tyler County Judge's Office. A copy of the Application is attached hereto as part of Appendix "A" and shall include the following information:
 - 2.1.1 Applicant's Name, Address, and Telephone Number;
 - 2.1.2 Name of any organization if different from Applicant;
 - 2.1.3 Start and End date(s) and time(s) of assembly and/or demonstration;
 - 2.1.4 Estimated attendance;
 - 2.1.5 Nature or brief description of program;
 - 2.1.6 Applicant's signature Agreement on Conditions of Use of Government
-

Facilities, a copy attached hereto as Appendix "A".

- 2.3 Applications must be submitted in accord with the following schedule, based upon the number of attendance:
 - 2.3.1 Groups of twenty five (25) or fewer: at least fifteen (15) days, but not more than (90) days prior to the requested date of use;
 - 2.3.2 Groups of twenty six (26) to one hundred (100): at least (30) days, but not more than (90) days prior to the requested date of use;
 - 2.3.3 Groups in excess of one hundred (100) at least forty-five (45) days, but not more than one hundred and twenty (120) days prior to the requested date of use.
- 2.4 For demonstration applications with an estimated attendance of 200 or greater, a certificate of insurance, in the amount of at least \$1,000,000, naming Tyler County as an additional insured, shall be provided to the County Judge, prior to a permit being approved and issued.
- 2.5 Tyler County may place, time, manner and place restrictions or variances upon any assembly or demonstration. Restrictions or variances may be considered depending upon security needs, number of attendees, vendor spaces needed, and the use of additional non-county property adjacent to County property.

3.0 POLICY ON PUBLIC DISPLAYS, DECORATIONS, OR MONUMENTS ON COUNTY PROPERTY

- 3.1 Except those areas that have been established as public forums as a matter of law, Tyler County property has not been by tradition or designation a public forum. Tyler County may contract with individuals or private groups to place displays or decorate County property, however, any displays placed on County property are for Tyler County's intended purpose;
 - 3.2 Any personal property left unattended on County property will be removed;
 - 3.3 No permanent structures, fixtures, or displays will be permitted on County property without prior County Commissioner Court approval;
 - 3.4 Any requests for displays, decorations, or monuments shall be made, in writing, and directed to the Tyler County Judge. The written request should include:
 - 3.4.1 The name of the individual and organization making the request;
 - 3.4.2 A description of the item(s) requested to be displayed on County Property;
 - 3.4.3 The location upon County Property where you would like to place the display;
 - 3.4.4 The date you would like to begin the display, and the name, address and telephone number of the person who will be responsible for erecting and maintaining the display;
-

- 3.4.5 The date the display will end and the name, address, and telephone number of the person who will be responsible for removing the display.

 - 3.5 With respect to requests made pursuant to Section 3.0 of this policy, any member of the Commissioners Court may request an item to be reviewed and amended on a Commissioners Court Agenda for consideration by the Court. If any single County Commissioner disapproves of the County Judge's approval or denial of a request, the Commissioner can have the matter placed on a Commissioners Court Agenda for consideration by the Commissioners Court as a whole.
 - 3.7 It is acknowledged that the County Commissioners Court has control over any monument, display, or decoration placed on County property. The County Commissioners' Court specifically reserves the right to:
 - 3.7.1 Approve or deny, in whole or in part, any request for display on County property;
 - 3.7.2 Rescind or modify any approval of a display at any time;
 - 3.7.3 Control the location of the display and set the duration to allow the display, if any;
 - 3.7.4 Control the message that is delivered to the public by the use of property owned by Tyler County.

APPENDIX A

AGREEMENT ON TERMS AND CONDITIONS OR USE OF TYLER COUNTY TEXAS PROPERTY

A.1.0 Collection of Revenue

A.1.1 There must be total public access to all events. Applicant may not charge a premises use fee to any person wishing to enter event or for the use of County Owned Property. This does not prohibit the selling of merchandise, vendor booths, or other commercial activity, so long as commercial activity is not conditioned upon entry to event or upon property.

A.2.0 Rules of Use

A.2.1 User will maintain at the event at all times a copy of the signed Permit approval and will present to any law enforcement officer or any elected county official, upon request.

A.2.2 Users will be responsible for the cleaning of County property during and at the conclusion of use;

A.2.3 There may be limited or no use of County electricity, water, or other utilities. The permissible use of outdoor property does not necessarily contemplate the use of any indoor facilities and the use of indoor facilities or utilities will not be authorized without express approval by County Judge or the Commissioner who has Court assigned oversight of the requested property.

A.2.4 There will be NO overnight demonstrations or camping on County property. Use of County property for multiple days does not authorize overnight stays;

A.2.5 All County property is drug and alcohol free, and the possession of either is strictly prohibited.

A.2.6 County property shall be vacated promptly at the expiration of event permit;

A.2.7 No demonstration or assembly will be allowed to be disruptive or cause a breach of the peace. No excessive noise will be allowed. Any excessive noise or disturbance of the peace may result in the permit being voided and the event canceled;

A.2.8 With the exceptions of certified peace officers or statutorily authorized County, State, or Federal employees there will be no firearms on County property;

A.2.9 No portable toilets may be placed on County property without prior approval from the County Judge or a standing approval of the Commissioners Court.

A.3.0 Agreement on Condition of Use

The User agrees to the following as a condition of use:

A.3.1 Adherence to all of the rules listed above in A.2.0 and the applicant's best efforts to ensure that all event attendees are in adherence;

- A.3.2 User assumes the duty to inspect the premises prior to use for any unsafe condition and to notify a representative of Tyler County if an unsafe condition is found. In the event that any unsafe condition is found, that cannot be corrected or cured prior to the start of the event, the event should be canceled or postponed until the condition can be rectified for safety.
- A.3.3 To notify a representative of Tyler County and to immediately cease use of County property at any time the use of the premises becomes unsafe.
- A.3.4 Not to interfere in any way with the operation of county business;
- A.3.5 Ensure that attendees and the property of Tyler County, Texas are free from harm or damage;
- A.3.6 Not to build, erect, affix, attach any equipment or permanent structure to any structure or fixture upon Tyler County property. When attaching temporary displays for use during permitted demonstration times, users will not use nails, screws, or any similar fasteners to attach said displays to County structures or fixtures, including the trees and landscaping on County property.
- A.3.7 To ensure that no illegal activity is taking place on County property; and
- A.3.8 To report any damage to County property as soon as it is known.

A.4.0 Defense, Indemnity, and Release of Tyler County

- A.4.1 Applicant agrees that Tyler County will not be responsible for any losses whatsoever.
- A.4.2 APPLICANT HEREBY AGREES TO RELEASE FROM LIABILITY, DEFEND, AND INDEMNIFY TYLER COUNTY TEXAS, ITS OFFICERS, ELECTED OFFICIALS, AGENTS, AND EMPLOYEES FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY, SPECIFICALLY INCLUDING, BUT IN NO WAY LIMITED TO ANY ACCIDENTS OR EVENTS CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF TYLER COUNTY, TEXAS, INCLUDING GROSS NEGLIGENCE, OR ITS OFFICERS, ELECTED OFFICIALS, AGENTS, AND EMPLOYEES, WHETHER IT BE PROPERTY DAMAGE OR PERSONAL INJURY (INCLUDING DEATH), ARISING OUT OF THE APPLICANT'S USE OF COUNTY PROPERTY.

A.5.0 Default

- A.5.1 Applicant agrees that any violation of any of the Rules, Terms or Conditions of this agreement can result in revocation of any permit, and the immediate cancelation of any scheduled event, assembly, or demonstration.
 - A.5.2 In addition to the above, Applicant also agrees that any violation may result in the denial of any future application of Applicant or Applicant's Organization.
 - A.5.3 Applicant agrees to repair or to make full restitution to Tyler County for any damage to County property as a result of Applicant's event.
