Commissioner Nash called a **workshop** to discuss the needs for the **proposed building (old Brookshire Bros) acquisition on North Charlton Street**. Commissioner Walston stated that they needed to know how many employees in adult and juvenile probation would be housed there. Judge Blanchette reported 7 employees with adult probation and 3 with juvenile probation. These departments will need to be separate entrances due to requirements by law.

Mr. O'Neal presented some drawings with how the building is set up now with the General Dollar Store and the Texas Workforce Center. He also presented a preliminary set up. Commissioner Walston stated that the Texas Workforce Center space would need to "come out". Matt proposed to have a section for classrooms, a reception area and each officer has to have a closed door office. Terry Allen suggested to have Joe Smith look up the law concerning the requirements of separating the adult and juvenile offenders as to what spaces can be shared and not shared.

Mrs. Allen reported the complications of using the J.P. courtroom. She and Commissioner Walston suggested maybe moving the Justice of Peace over to this building. It would free up more space for the sheriff's department.

It was Commissioner Nash's opinion that the primary goal should be moving Adult Probation and then a courtroom that could be designed for jury trial purposes. Lou Cloy suggested the courtroom be large enough to hold 100 people, in the event that the district courtroom is not available due to renovation or other reasons. Judge Blanchette thought having a courtroom there could also be used for commissioners' court. A proposed need was discussed for a courtroom, jury room with access to a restroom, conference room and two offices that could be used for the district clerk and district judge (to be used in the event the 2nd floor of the courthouse is being renovated) Judge Blanchette stated the architect should ask questions of the needs of all the departments, such as Adult and Juvenile Probation, District Clerk, etc. Terry Allen requested having the outside of the building well light due to working after hours.


The next step will be to hire an architect and contact contractors.

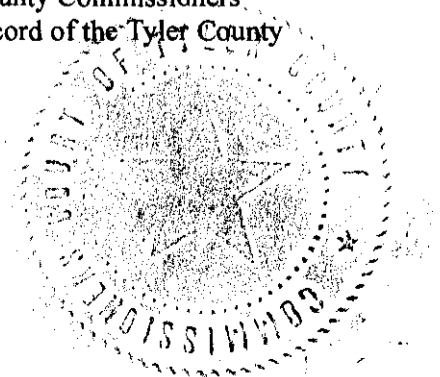
Commissioner Walston made the motion to adjourn the meeting. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded. All voted yes.

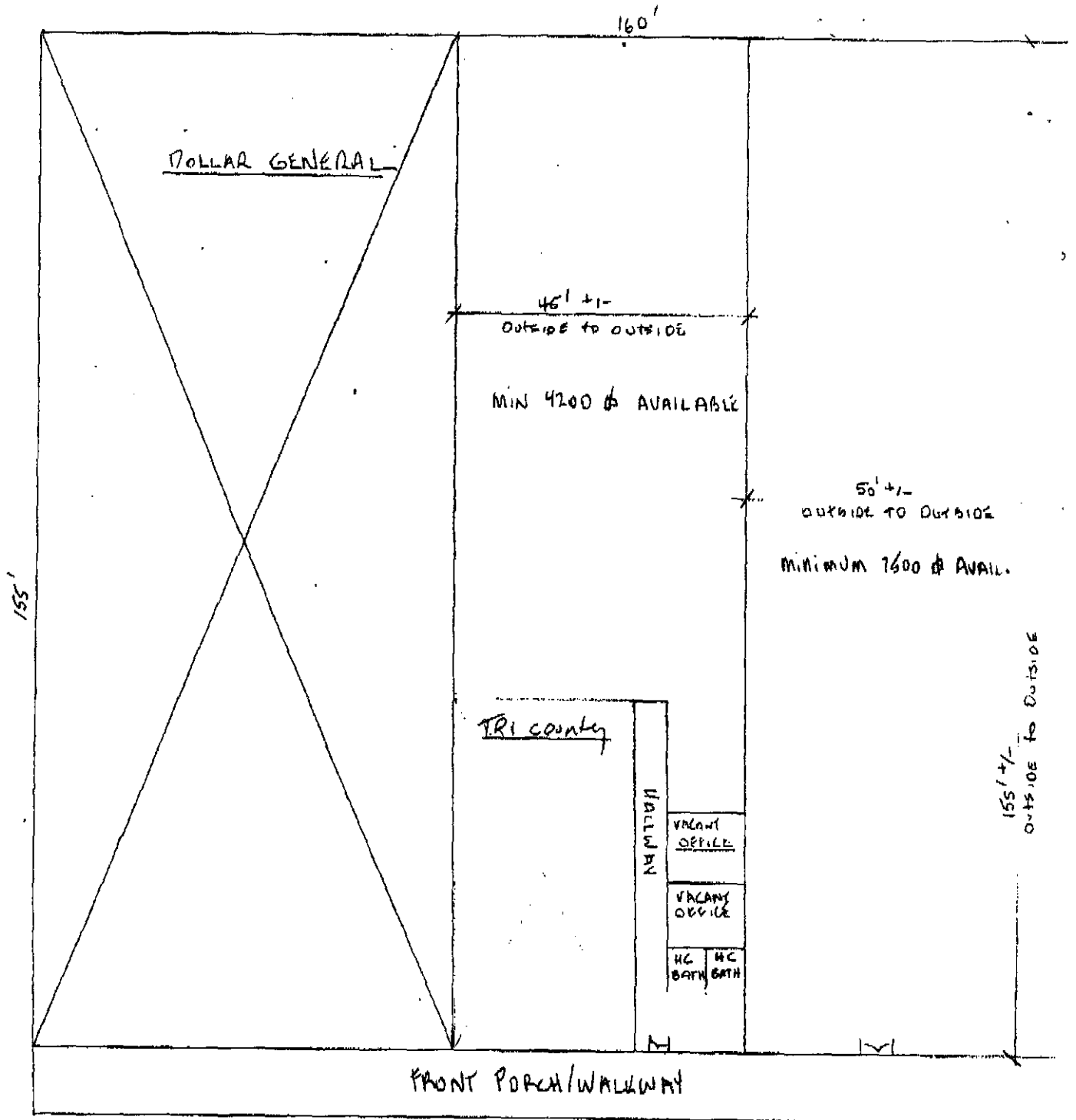
