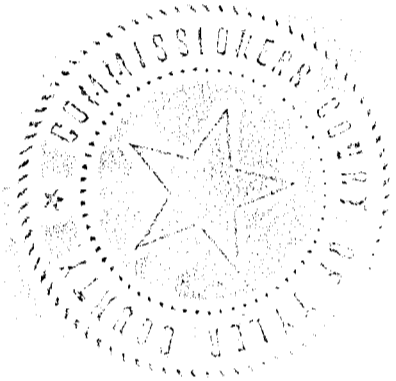
A motion was made by Commissioner Hughes that the meeting adjourn. It was seconded by Commissioner Walston. All voted yes and none no.

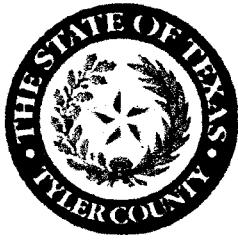
THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS, THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED AT 2:03 pm

CONTINUATION OF DISASTER DECLARATION

OFFICE OF THE COUNTY JUDGE
Jacques L. Blanchette
COUNTY of TYLER

WHEREAS, the County of Tyler, on the 5th day of June, 2015, is in threat of damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from conditions created by torrential rainfall over an excessive period of time, affecting Tyler County by causing flooding in populated areas as well as major infrastructure damage preventing access to or the safe passage on various roadways. Such conditions create a public safety hazard.

WHEREAS, the County Judge of Tyler County, Texas has determined that extraordinary measures to protect or rehabilitate property are necessary and hereby ordered.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF TYLER COUNTY:

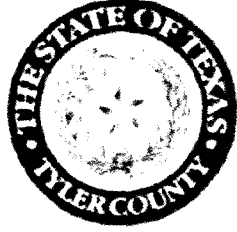
- That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Tyler County, Texas pursuant to Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code;
- Pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seventy-five days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners' Court of Tyler County, Texas;
- Pursuant to Section 418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
- Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the county/city Emergency Management Plan.

EFFECTIVE this 5th day of June, 2015.

Dear Governor Abbott:


As a result of the May 27th flood, Tyler County is currently facing both physical and economic losses. An estimated 85 plus homes have been affected with 115 families needing temporary housing, and/or assistance. No known businesses have sustained uninsured losses.

Likewise, public utilities have been impacted and left without electricity, telephones and potable water. The public works and county roads damaged in Tyler County have affected 115 homes which were isolated. It is estimated that road and bridge damage will exceed \$290,000.

It is my belief the damage to homes, businesses, public works and utility systems constitutes a public health and safety hazard. I have determined that this incident is of such severity and magnitude that an effective response may be beyond Tyler County's capability to recover without supplementary State or Federal assistance.

Your assistance in this matter, as it affects the safety and health needs of our citizens would be appreciated.
