David Luther, Chief Appraiser for Tyler County Tax Appraisal District and deacon in the  
Catholic Church delivered the invocation. Commissioner Hughes led the Pledge of Allegiance to  
the Texas flag.

Constable Jim Zachary presented the quarterly report for the constables.

A motion was made by Commissioner Marshall and seconded by Commissioner Hughes to  
receive minutes from the previous meeting. All voted yes and none no.

**Budget amendments/line item transfers** were not presented.

**Commissioner Hughes** motioned to approve paying the county **bills**. The motion was seconded  
by **Commissioner Nash**. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

**Commissioner Marshall** motioned to adopt the **resolution** for a grant for body cameras for the  
**Sheriff's department**. **Commissioner Nash** seconded the motion. The cost to the county would  
be around \$6700 to be paid out of office equipment. All voted yes and none no. SEE  
ATTACHED

**Commissioner Marshall** motioned to award bids to all vendors that turned in a bid for **road  
materials**. **Commissioner Hughes** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

**Commissioner Nash** motioned to award the bid of Gardner Oil for **petroleum products**.  
**Commissioner Marshall** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Hughes** and seconded by **Commissioner Marshall** to  
reappoint Martin Nash to the **DETCOG Board** for the 2016/2017 term. All voted yes and none  
no.

**Commissioner Nash** motioned to approve transferring funds from the **District Attorney  
Forfeiture Fund Account** to the **general fund** to supplement **salaries** in the **Criminal District  
Attorney's office**. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Hughes** to approve the **quarterly investment report**, as  
presented by the County Treasurer. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Nash**. All  
voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

**Commissioner Marshall** motioned to appoint the members to the **truancy committee** as  
requested by Terry Allen. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Nash**. All voted yes and  
none no. SEE ATTACHED

**Commissioner Nash** motioned to approve the **Texas State Guard Maritime Regiment** to use office and storage space at the Nutrition Center. This regiment is part of the Texas National Guard directly under the Governor. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Marshall**. All voted yes and none no.

The County Auditor introduced Robert Rueese with the **TAC RMP Risk Control Reimbursement Program**. This would be a reimbursement plan for safety programs. Tyler County would qualify for \$22,662.00 for risk management projects. An additional \$6254.00 is available for **law enforcement** projects. The deadline to submit the application is July 1<sup>st</sup>.

There was also a presentation by a TAC representative concerning the **Affordable Care Act**. The Act defines a full-time employee as one who works 30 hours a week or 130 hours a month and therefore qualifies for health coverage. She recommended using a 12-month period for measuring hours of **part-time employees**.

**Commissioner Marshall** motioned to amend the motion concerning **road materials** to include the award of cracked fuel oil to Bryan and Bryan. **Commissioner Hughes** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

No one was present concerning the **US Department of Agriculture Rural Development Housing Program**.

No one was present representing the **Tyler County Historical Commission**. This presentation will be given next month.


Executive Session was not held.

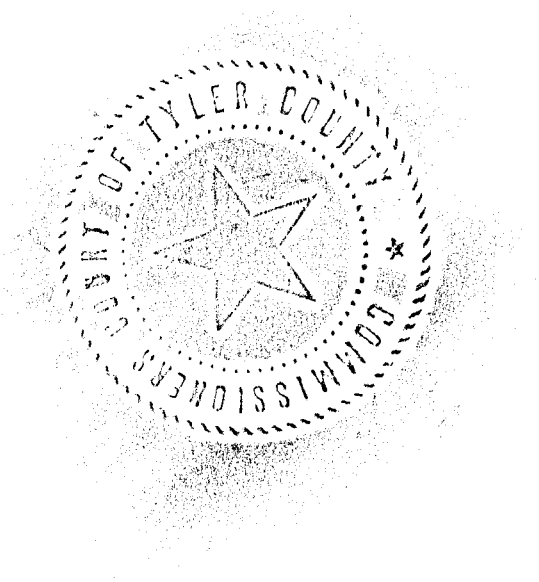
A motion was made by Commissioner Nash and seconded by Commissioner Marshall that the meeting adjourn. All voted yes and none no.



2. DEFINITIONS: In order to simplify the language throughout this bid the following definitions shall Apply.

**COUNTY:** The Government of Tyler County, Texas and its authorized representations.  
**TYLER COUNTY:** Same as County  
**CONTRACTORS:** The successful Bidder(s) of this bid request.  
**SUPPLIER:** Same as Contractor  
**SUB-CONTRACTOR:** Any contractor hired by the Contractor or Supplier to furnish materials and services specified in this bid request.  
**COMMISSIONER'S COURT:** The elected officials of Tyler County, Texas given the authority to exercise such powers and jurisdiction of all county business as conferred by the State Constitution and Laws.  
**CONTRACT:** An agreement between the County and a Supplier to furnish supplies and/or Services over a designated period of time during which repeated purchases are made of the commodity specified.
3. ERRORS QUANTITY: Bids must be submitted on units of quantity specified. In the event of errors extended prices the unit price shall govern. **COUNTY OF TYLER, STATE OF TEXAS  
FACILITIES USE AGREEMENT**

This agreement, made by and between Tyler County, State of Texas, hereinafter referred to as "the County" and the Texas State Guard Maritime Regiment, hereinafter referred to as the "Tenant"

**WITNESSETH**

**WHEREAS** the County owns certain facilities as described in this agreement; and

**WHEREAS** Tenant desires to occupy those premises for the purposes herein contained; and

**WHEREAS** Tenant's occupation and use of premises will be for public purposes.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions herein contained, the County and the Tenant agree as follows:

1.0 Grant:

The County, for and in consideration of the covenants, conditions and agreements to be done and performed by the Tenant, hereby grants permission to Tenant to utilize, use and share with County the following described facilities: Emergency Management offices and facilities located at 200 Veterans Way, Woodville, Texas, hereinafter referred to as the "Facility", for the sole purpose of housing the mission ready operations of the Texas Maritime Regiment at no cost. Tenant warrants that it has physically inspected the Facility and accepts the Facility in its present condition, "as is", is suitable for its operational requirements.

2.0 Term:

- Initial Term: This agreement shall become effective upon its execution by both Parties and shall continue in force for an initial term of five (5) years, unless sooner terminated as provided herein.
- Renewal: Upon completion of its initial term, and provided that Tenant is not in default under this Agreement, the Agreement may be renewed by the County for two (2) additional five (5) year terms, subject to written approval by both parties and to any modifications to the Agreement as are mutually agreeable.
- Termination for Convenience: Notwithstanding any other provision, this Agreement may be terminated, in whole or in part, with sixty (60) days written notice, at the County's sole discretion, if it is determined that such termination is in the best interest of the County.
- Specifics: Tenant shall be permitted to exclusively utilize the designated portable office building and one (1) conex box located in the north fenced lot as well as the north end of the larger secondary fenced lot for the term of this Agreement, whereas the remainder of the facility belonging to the Emergency Management offices shall be utilized on a shared basis by the Tenant during predetermined times as published by Tenant. **COUNTY HEREBY DISCLAIMS AND TENANT WAIVES THE BENEFIT OF ANY AND ALL IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF HABITABILITY, FITNESS OR SUITABILITY FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. TENANT ACKNOWLEDGES THAT NEITHER THE COUNTY NOR ANY AGENT OF THE COUNTY HAD MADE ANY REPRESENTATIONS OR WARRANTY WITH RESPECT TO THE FACILITY OR SUITABILITY OF THE FACILITY FOR THE PURPOSE HEREIN INTENDED. BY OCCUPYING THE FACILITY, TENANT IS DEEMED TO HAVE ACCEPTED THE FACILITY AS SUITABLE FOR ITS PURPOSE.**

- Time shall be of the essence in this Agreement. The time granted for the use of the facility or for the installation or removal of equipment shall not be extended without written permission of the County.

### 3.0 Alterations, Additions or Replacements:

Tenant shall make no alterations, additions or replacement or improvements to any part of the Facility other than those expressly approved in writing by the County beforehand upon commencement of the Agreement, nor shall Tenant install any equipment that requires any electrical connection other than a standard wall plug or floor receptacle nor make any changes in those electrical connections installed at the Facility and premises without prior written consent of the County Commissioners Court. Any electrical service other than that provided at the execution of this Agreement shall be installed and provided at Tenant's sole cost and expense.

### 4.0 Maintenance of Facility and Improvements:

- General Maintenance: Tenant shall maintain the Facility and premises and all improvements, additions or alterations to the Facility in good working order and in a condition based on a standard of care reflecting prudent property management, reasonable wear and tear excepted. For any required general maintenance, the County agrees to supply maintenance materials and Tenant agrees to perform all labor for general maintenance at its sole cost and expense.
- Preventive Maintenance and Repair: Tenant shall perform, at its sole expense, ordinary preventive maintenance and ordinary upkeep and repair of all Tenant owned structures, personal property and equipment at the facility.
- Off-Property Repair: Tenant shall, at its sole expense, immediately repair any and all damage in or to any area of the Facility occasioned by the intentional or negligent acts, omissions or fault of the Tenant, its agents or employees, and shall immediately remove any litter, debris, petroleum products or other liquids, waste or grease that may result from its operations or the activities of its agents, employees or suppliers.
- Maintenance or Repair by the County upon Tenants Default: (a) In the event that Tenant defaults to perform any obligation required by this Section to be performed by Tenant at Tenant's cost for a period of fifteen (15) days after receipt of written notice from the County to do so, the County, upon the expiration of the fifteen (15) day period may, but shall not be obligated to, perform that obligation of Tenant, which may include entry upon the premises and Facility if reasonably required. (b) Notwithstanding the foregoing, in the event that Tenant's failure to perform such of its obligations under this Section, endanger the health and safety of the public, the County May, but shall not be obligated to, perform the obligation of the Tenant upon prior written notice of its intent to do so, without awaiting the expiration of the fifteen (15) day period. (c) In the event that the County performs any obligation of Tenant under this Section, then the County is entitled to invoice the Tenant for the reasonable cost and expense of performing such obligations, plus fifteen percent (15%) administrative charge, and Tenant shall pay such amount on or before the first day of the next month. (d) The County shall not be liable to Tenant for any loss, cost or expense to Tenant resulting for the County's performance of Tenant's obligations in accordance with the provisions of the Section.

### 5.0 Entry and Inspection of Facility:

- Entry and Inspection: The County and its authorized officers, employees, agents, contractors, subcontractors or other representatives shall have the right to enter upon the premises and Facility: (a) During reasonable business hours to determine whether Tenant is complying with the terms and conditions of this Agreement; (b) During reasonable business hours for the purpose of inspecting the



premises and Facility and for the purposes of fulfilling the County's obligations under the Agreement, provided, however, that entry shall be at such times and such manner as not to interfere unreasonably with the operations of the Tenant; and (c) At any time as may be required by an emergency or for emergency repairs or maintenance, without any liability or responsibility to Tenant for loss of business.

- No Termination or Interference: No entry by or on behalf of the County upon the premises and Facility shall cause or constitute a termination of the Agreement, nor be deemed to constitute an interference with Tenant's possession/use of the Facility, nor constitute a revocation of or interference with any of Tenant's rights concerning use of the Facility.

#### 6.0 Applicable Laws:

Tenant agrees to comply with all applicable laws, ordinances and rules for the County, the State of Texas and the United States.

Tenant warrants that it will occupy the Facility and conduct its activities in a manner that complies with all of the applicable provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). 

FACILITIES USE AGREEMENT**

This agreement, made by and between Tyler County, State of Texas, hereinafter referred to as "the County" and the Texas State Guard Maritime Regiment, hereinafter referred to as the "Tenant"

**WITNESSETH**

**WHEREAS** the County owns certain facilities as described in this agreement; and

**WHEREAS** Tenant desires to occupy those premises for the purposes herein contained; and

**WHEREAS** Tenant's occupation and use of premises will be for public purposes.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions herein contained, the County and the Tenant agree as follows:

1.0 Grant:

The County, for and in consideration of the covenants, conditions and agreements to be done and performed by the Tenant, hereby grants permission to Tenant to utilize, use and share with County the following described facilities: Emergency Management offices and facilities located at 200 Veterans Way, Woodville, Texas, hereinafter referred to as the "Facility", for the sole purpose of housing the mission ready operations of the Texas Maritime Regiment at no cost. Tenant warrants that it has physically inspected the Facility and accepts the Facility in its present condition, "as is", is suitable for its operational requirements.

2.0 Term:

- Initial Term: This agreement shall become effective upon its execution by both Parties and shall continue in force for an initial term of five (5) years, unless sooner terminated as provided herein.
- Renewal: Upon completion of its initial term, and provided that Tenant is not in default under this Agreement, the Agreement may be renewed by the County for two (2) additional five (5) year terms, subject to written approval by both parties and to any modifications to the Agreement as are mutually agreeable.
- Termination for Convenience: Notwithstanding any other provision, this Agreement may be terminated, in whole or in part, with sixty (60) days written notice, at the County's sole discretion, if it is determined that such termination is in the best interest of the County.
- Specifics: Tenant shall be permitted to exclusively utilize the designated portable office building and one (1) conex box located in the north fenced lot as well as the north end of the larger secondary fenced lot for the term of this Agreement, whereas the remainder of the facility belonging to the Emergency Management offices shall be utilized on a shared basis by the Tenant during predetermined times as published by Tenant. **COUNTY HEREBY DISCLAIMS AND TENANT WAIVES THE BENEFIT OF ANY AND ALL IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF HABITABILITY, FITNESS OR SUITABILITY FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. TENANT ACKNOWLEDGES THAT NEITHER THE COUNTY NOR ANY AGENT OF THE COUNTY HAD MADE ANY REPRESENTATIONS OR WARRANTY WITH RESPECT TO THE FACILITY OR SUITABILITY OF THE FACILITY FOR THE PURPOSE HEREIN INTENDED. BY OCCUPYING THE FACILITY, TENANT IS DEEMED TO HAVE ACCEPTED THE FACILITY AS SUITABLE FOR ITS PURPOSE.**

- Time shall be of the essence in this Agreement. The time granted for the use of the facility or for the installation or removal of equipment shall not be extended without written permission of the County.

### 3.0 Alterations, Additions or Replacements:

Tenant shall make no alterations, additions or replacement or improvements to any part of the Facility other than those expressly approved in writing by the County beforehand upon commencement of the Agreement, nor shall Tenant install any equipment that requires any electrical connection other than a standard wall plug or floor receptacle nor make any changes in those electrical connections installed at the Facility and premises without prior written consent of the County Commissioners Court. Any electrical service other than that provided at the execution of this Agreement shall be installed and provided at Tenant's sole cost and expense.

### 4.0 Maintenance of Facility and Improvements:

- General Maintenance: Tenant shall maintain the Facility and premises and all improvements, additions or alterations to the Facility in good working order and in a condition based on a standard of care reflecting prudent property management, reasonable wear and tear excepted. For any required general maintenance, the County agrees to supply maintenance materials and Tenant agrees to perform all labor for general maintenance at its sole cost and expense.
- Preventive Maintenance and Repair: Tenant shall perform, at its sole expense, ordinary preventive maintenance and ordinary upkeep and repair of all Tenant owned structures, personal property and equipment at the facility.
- Off-Property Repair: Tenant shall, at its sole expense, immediately repair any and all damage in or to any area of the Facility occasioned by the intentional or negligent acts, omissions or fault of the Tenant, its agents or employees, and shall immediately remove any litter, debris, petroleum products or other liquids, waste or grease that may result from its operations or the activities of its agents, employees or suppliers.
- Maintenance or Repair by the County upon Tenants Default: (a) In the event that Tenant defaults to perform any obligation required by this Section to be performed by Tenant at Tenant's cost for a period of fifteen (15) days after receipt of written notice from the County to do so, the County, upon the expiration of the fifteen (15) day period may, but shall not be obligated to, perform that obligation of Tenant, which may include entry upon the premises and Facility if reasonably required. (b) Notwithstanding the foregoing, in the event that Tenant's failure to perform such of its obligations under this Section, endanger the health and safety of the public, the County May, but shall not be obligated to, perform the obligation of the Tenant upon prior written notice of its intent to do so, without awaiting the expiration of the fifteen (15) day period. (c) In the event that the County performs any obligation of Tenant under this Section, then the County is entitled to invoice the Tenant for the reasonable cost and expense of performing such obligations, plus fifteen percent (15%) administrative charge, and Tenant shall pay such amount on or before the first day of the next month. (d) The County shall not be liable to Tenant for any loss, cost or expense to Tenant resulting for the County's performance of Tenant's obligations in accordance with the provisions of the Section.

### 5.0 Entry and Inspection of Facility:

- Entry and Inspection: The County and its authorized officers, employees, agents, contractors, subcontractors or other representatives shall have the right to enter upon the premises and Facility: (a) During reasonable business hours to determine whether Tenant is complying with the terms and conditions of this Agreement; (b) During reasonable business hours for the purpose of inspecting the



premises and Facility and for the purposes of fulfilling the County's obligations under the Agreement, provided, however, that entry shall be at such times and such manner as not to interfere unreasonably with the operations of the Tenant; and (c) At any time as may be required by an emergency or for emergency repairs or maintenance, without any liability or responsibility to Tenant for loss of business.

- No Termination or Interference: No entry by or on behalf of the County upon the premises and Facility shall cause or constitute a termination of the Agreement, nor be deemed to constitute an interference with Tenant's possession/use of the Facility, nor constitute a revocation of or interference with any of Tenant's rights concerning use of the Facility.

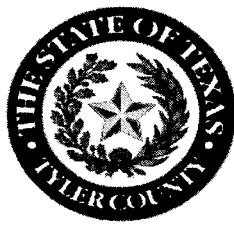
