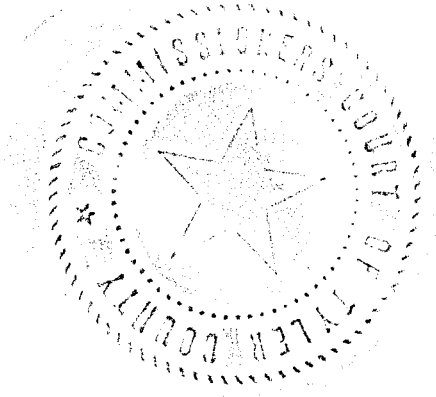
Being their last action before their retirement, A motion was made by Commissioner Walston and seconded by Commissioner Hughes that the meeting adjourn. All voted yes.
