Commissioners' Court in and for Tyler County, Texas convened in a Regular Meeting at the
District Courtroom in Woodville, Texas, the following members of the Court present, to wit:

The following were absent: Judge Blanchette and Commissioner Marshall thereby constituting
a quorum. In addition to the above were:
JACKIE SKINNER COUNTY AUDITOR

Judge ProTem Nash called the meeting to order and then delivered the invocation. Commissioner
Sturrock led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the American flag.

Persons had not signed up to make comments. Therefore, there were no public comments.

Minutes were not presented.

The County Auditor presented a line item transfer from the County Treasurer moving money
from telephone to office supplies. **Commissioner Nash** motioned to table **budget amendments**
/line item transfers. **Commissioner Sturrock** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Nash made the motion to approve the **accounts payable**; and paying the **county bills**.
The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Hudson**. All yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Sturrock** to approve the **District Clerk's monthly**
report for September 2020. **Commissioner Hudson** seconded the motion. All voted yes and
none no. SEE ATTACHED REPORT

A motion was made by **Commissioner Sturrock** to renew the contract for the postage machine
with Pitney Bowes for the **Sheriff's department**. **Commissioner Nash** seconded the motion.
All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Sturrock** and seconded by **Commissioner Hudson** to
renew the contract with **GHS for court collection services**, as requested by Justice Trisher Ford.
All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Hudson motioned to table consideration of CRF reimbursement requests from
Colmesneil, Chester and Spurger ISDs, until amounts and inter-local agreements are presented.
Commissioner Sturrock seconded the motion. All voted yes none no.

Commissioner Sturrock motioned to participate in seeking the **DETCOG Community**
Development Block Grant Mitigation (MIT) funds for Public Safety Communications
Infrastructure Project that will provide region wide interoperable radio service in all 12
counties in the DETCOG region. Tyler County does not have this type of radio service currently.
The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Hudson**. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Sturrock** and seconded by **Commissioner Hudson** to
approve the 1% match of \$40,000 for the DETCOG **CDBG Mitigation grant** to be paid out of
the Contingency Fund, for the **Public Safety Communications Infrastructure Project**. All
voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Sturrock** to approve payment to Dollar General
Cooperation for the invoice for repairs to the HVAC unit in the Dollar General building.
Commissioner Hudson seconded the motion. The County Auditor reported the amount is
\$1689.54. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Nash** and seconded by **Commissioner Sturrock** to approve Joe Blacksher attending the newly elected Commissioners' conference in Tyler, Tx on December 10, 2020. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Sturrock** and seconded by **Commissioner Nash** to table designating an Official, for the county, to have certifying and signature authority for all grants and leases. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Sturrock motioned to renew the **CJIS security hardware maintenance package**. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Nash**. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Sturrock motion to approve a one-year lease (\$1754 per month) property close to the Appraisal District from Milton Moffett for office space for courthouse employees (Juvenile Probation) during the **courthouse remediation/rehabilitation**. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Hudson**. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Sturrock reported he has a meeting on Thursday with the architect and contractor concerning the time-line and plan to where they will begin the work.

Executive Session was not held.


Motion made by Commissioner Hudson that the meeting be adjourned. Commissioner Sturrock seconded.
