Commissioner Marshall called the meeting to order. The invocation was delivered by Jackie Skinner. Commissioner Marshall led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Texas flag.

Persons had not signed up to make comments. Therefore, there were no public comments.

A motion was made by Commissioner Sturrock and seconded by Commissioner Marshall to receive the minutes of October 26 and November 2nd. All vote yes and none no.

Budget Amendments/Line Item Transfers were not presented.

**Commissioner Hudson** made a motion to approve **Accounts Payable/County Bills**, as presented by the **County Auditor**. **Commissioner Sturrock** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

**Commissioner Sturrock** motioned to open bids for the **GLO CDBG-DR Contract No. 20-065-087-C248 and City of Woodville Highway 190 and Industrial Water Well Generator Project**. **Commissioner Hudson** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. The following base bids were received for the **Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project**:

A motion was made by **Commissioner Sturrock** to set the hourly rate at \$16 per hour; starting date to be December 2, 2020; and ending date to be October 19, 2021 for a **courthouse remediation project manager**. This will be paid using funds previously budget for a temporary position at the Driver's License office. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Marshall**. All yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Hudson** and seconded by **Commissioner Sturrock** to approve the annual First National Bank ACH and wire transfer contracts. All voted yes and none no. *SEE ATTACHED*

**Commissioner Hudson** made a motion to renew the **Net Data Annual Software Maintenance and IT support/maintenance** for county offices. **Commissioner Sturrock** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Hudson** and seconded by **Commissioner Sturrock** to renew the annual **iWorQ Systems Internet Software Management and Support** for the **Sheriff's department**. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

**Commissioner Sturrock** motioned to accept a proposal from the **Tyer County Historical Commission** to explore the construction of a display of the courthouse historical bell and clock on the courthouse grounds to be funded by donation from TCHC, if feasible. The motion was

seconded by **Commissioner Hudson**. Eleanor Holderman presented the TCHC's proposal to present the bell and clock in an appropriate way using the funds collected (\$100,000) previously for restoration of the 1891 courthouse; celebrating the 100th anniversary of Tyler County on April 4, 2021 desires to have plans in place by that date. She described similar displays in Newton County and Harris County. All voted yes and none no.

**Commissioner Sturrock** motioned that once requirements and minimal standards are received from THC, Tyler County will issue a request for proposals for a qualified architect for the display of the courthouse bell and clock. **Commissioner Hudson** seconded the motion. Commissioner Sturrock added that Mrs. Holderman covered in her presentation there would be not cost to the county and this would allow the historical commission to pursue the cost to see if it is within their means to pay for it; and "we will go from there". All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Sturrock** and seconded by **Commissioner Hudson** to purchase a **Copsync Mobile Annual Contract**. This will serve as an investigative tool providing a way the Sheriff's department can interact with Woodville ISD concerning incidents. The cost is \$800 per year. All votes yes and none no.

**Commissioner Sturrock** motioned to purchase a 2021 Chevrolet pickup for the **Sheriff's department**. **Commissioner Hudson** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

Executive Session was not held.

Motion made by Commissioner Sturrock that the meeting be adjourned. Commissioner Hudson seconded. All voted yes none no.
