Commissioner Nash called the meeting to order, presiding as Judge Pro-Tem. The invocation  
was delivered by Joe Blacksher. Commissioner Marshall led the Pledge of Allegiance to the  
American Flag. Commissioner Nash announced this would be his last meeting.  
PUBLIC COMMENTS: State Representative, James White, presented a flag that had flown over  
the Texas State Capitol to Commissioner Nash in honor of his service to Tyler County. The  
Texas House of Representatives acknowledges Commissioner Nash's service as a board member  
to DETCOG; his counsel to at least two governors; and, speaking to members of the legislature.  
As a personal gift, he gave him silver cuff-links with the Texas seal.

Minutes were not presented.

**Commissioner Marshall** made a motion to receive the monthly reports from the **Juvenile and  
Adult Probation Departments, District Clerk, County Clerk, County Auditor, County  
Treasurer, County Extension and Justice of the Peace, Pct. 1. Commissioner Hudson**  
seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

**Budget amendments/line item transfers**, were not presented by the County Auditor.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Sturrock** and seconded by **Commissioner Marshall** to  
award the construction contract to Gulf Coast Electric in amount of \$165,500.00 for the  
**City of Woodville water improvements** portion of the General Land Office (GLO) Harvey  
Infrastructure Grant 20-065-087-C248. The City Manager stated the City was prepared to pay for  
any overages, including \$13,050.00 over the commitment for the water generator project. All  
voted yes and none no.

**Commissioner Marshall** motioned to award the construction contract to CJ Construction in the  
amount of \$84,089.00 for the **City of Woodville sewer line improvements** portion of the  
General Land Office (GLO) Harvey Infrastructure Grant 20-065-087-C248. The motion was  
seconded by **Commissioner Sturrock**. Tyler County had allocated \$82,510.00. The City Manager  
reported the City had taken action to cover any additional costs. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Nash** and seconded by **Commissioner Marshall** to  
approve the **Official Bond** for Joe Blacksher as Commissioner for Precinct #1. All voted yes and  
none no. SEE ATTACHED

No action was taken on Item G: paying for portable restrooms for Christmas in Tyler County out  
of CRF monies as it was a part of the COVID mitigation for social distancing and public health.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** to sign an extension for open enrollment with  
Aflac from 30 days to 90 days, as requested by the County Treasurer. The motion was seconded  
by **Commissioner Hudson**. All voted yes and none no.

**Commissioner Marshall** motioned to reimburse the Tyler County Youth Baseball in the amount of \$6000 toward the rebuilding of the concession stand. This will be paid from the Tyler County Youth Programs portion of the budget. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Sturrock**. All voted yes and none no.

**Commissioner Marshall** motioned to advertise for **bids to sell scrap metal** for all precincts. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Nash**. All voted yes and none no.

Executive Session was not held.


A motion was made by Commissioner Marshall and seconded by Commissioner Sturrock that the meeting adjourn. All voted yes.
