Maximum discussion on any Agenda item, regardless of the number of members of the public wishing to address the Court on any specific Agenda item (or items), shall be limited to thirty (30) minutes. In matters of exceptional interest to the Court, the Court, by a majority vote, may shorten or lengthen the time allocated for any or all Agenda items. Time for each speaker shall be maintained by the County Clerk or such other designated representative of the Commissioners Court.
3. Profane, insulting, or threatening language directed toward the Court and/or any person in the Court's presence and/or racial, ethnic, or gender slurs or epithets will not be tolerated.
