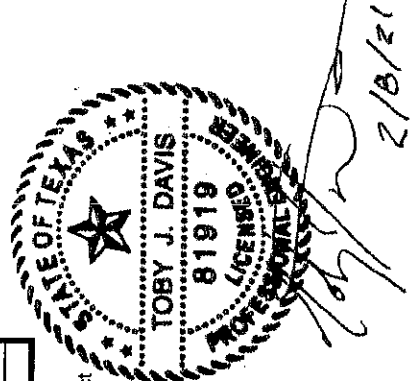

Core and Main	\$151,711.13



The Board Meeting minutes related to this action are attached.

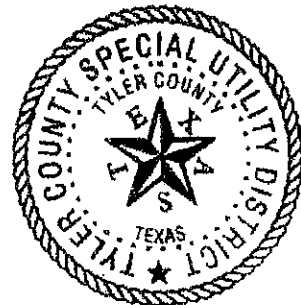

2. Discussion and consider action on Bid for Materials for Rockland Interconnecting Water Main (Phase I)

The Tyler County Commissioners Court opened these Bids on Monday, February 8, 2021, and subsequently, the Bid Results were forwarded to the Tyler County Special Utility District. These Bid Results were presented to the Board of Directors at the February 9, 2021 Board Meeting.

Rural Pipe and Supply	\$148,062.40
Core and Main	\$151,711.13

The TCSUD Board of Directors considered these Bid Results and made a recommendation as regarding the Award of Bid: Paul James moved that the recommendation for Bid Award be made for Rural Pipe and Supply with the low bid of \$148,062.40. A second was forthcoming from James Alfaro. A vote was called, and the Board voted a vote of unanimity for motion approval.

The Tyler County Commissioners Court will consider this recommendation and take the necessary action at a future Meeting of the Commissioners Court.
