After calling the meeting to order, Judge Blanchette stated "it is the practice of the court to exercise an invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag. Anyone who may not be comfortable with the practice may wish to step out of the room, or mute the video, and rejoin once the portion of the agenda begins with public comments." Commissioner Hudson delivered the invocation and then led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: none

Ken Jobe announced he would not be seeking a TDEM/HMPG Grant through DR-4485 to **establish base flood** elevations throughout the County. Judge Blanchette announced this item was not eligible for action. SEE ATTACHED

Accounts Payable/County Bills: none

Ken Jobe requested no action on this action item: Request for Proposal for FEMA DM-4855 for **Establishing Benchmark Elevation for National Flood Insurance Program**. Judge Blanchette announced this item was not eligible for action.

Commissioner Marshall motioned for approval to seek a TDEM/HMPG Grant through FEMA DR-4485 to conduct a **drainage project at Colmesneil ISD**. **Commissioner Blacksher** seconded the motion. Ken Jobe stated he has been in contact with TDEM and has presented a plan to the State. The CISD Superintendent described the washouts and need for the drainage project. This is a 25% matching grant. Commissioners Blacksher, Sturrock, Marshall and Hudson voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Marshall motioned to request proposals for a grant administrator for a FEMA DR-4485 Grant for the proposed **drainage project for Colmesneil ISD**. **Commissioner Sturrock** seconded the motion. Mr. Jobe stated it needs to run two weeks in the newspaper. Commissioners Blacksher, Sturrock, Marshall and Hudson voted yes and none voted no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Sturrock** and seconded by **Commissioner Marshall** to approve the **Agreement with Scott A. Durfee** to provide legal assistance on three appeal cases, as requested by the Criminal District Attorney. Commissioners Blacksher, Sturrock, Marshall and Hudson voted yes and none voted no. COMMENTS BY COURT MEMBERS PERTAINING to MATTERS of COUNTY GOVERNMENT: Commissioner Blacksher stated that GLO money is safe currently. Judge Blanchette added a public hearing will be held April 5th at the Tyler County Nutrition Center.

Executive Session was not held.


A motion was made by Commissioner Sturrock seconded by Commissioner Blacksher that the meeting adjourn. All voted yes.
