After calling the meeting to order, Commissioner Marshall stated "it is the practice of the court to exercise an invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag. Anyone who may not be comfortable with the practice may wish to step out into the hall and rejoin once the portion of the agenda begins with public comments." Commissioner Sturrock delivered the invocation and then led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Bonnie Pullen, Tyler County Booster Club, formerly Tyler County 4-H Booster Club, purposes to raise funds to support 4H kids. Recently posted "jackpots" at the rodeo arena. Also had one booked for July 22, 23. She had been informed that all 4-H events needed to be booked through Jacob Spivey. Mr. Spivey had stated he was not affiliated with the booster club. She expressed concern that the booster club had been informed they were no longer allowed to use the arena for their events, but would like to opportunity to use the arena for future events.

CONSIDER/APPROVE/INFORMATION:

A motion was made by **Commissioner Hudson** to award the bid for a front-end loader to Doggett in the amount of \$199,500. This one includes a grapple rake. The motion was seconded **Commissioner Blacksher**. Commissioner Blacksher, Commissioner Sturrock, Commissioner Marshall and Commissioner Hudson all voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Blacksher motioned to amend the **Subdivision Regulations Appendix Q and Appendix R** to reflect Tier 1 and Tier 2 development. **Commissioner Sturrock** seconded the motion. Commissioner Blacksher stated this is a change to specify by Tier 1 and Tier 2 rather than a by acreage and lots. A motion was made by **Commissioner Blacksher** and seconded by **Commissioner Sturrock** to amend the motion to include adding "plus any and all publication fees". Commissioner Blacksher, Commissioner Sturrock, Commissioner Marshall and Commissioner Hudson all voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Blacksher** to accept the proposed funding to Tyler County from the DETCOG method of distribution (MOD) for the regional mitigation program, part of the **State of Texas CDBG Mitigation Action Plan**. The motion was seconded Commissioner Sturrock. Commissioner Blacksher read aloud a letter from DETCOG. Commissioner Blacksher, Commissioner Sturrock, Commissioner Marshall and Commissioner Hudson all voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

GOVERNMENT: Sheriff Weatherford- the recent shooting at a school in Uvalde has affected law enforcement, other schools, the public, the nation. He has reached out to superintendents for round table discussions. He requested Commissioner Hudson, having previous school experience and Commissioner Sturrock with previous law enforcement experience, to attend the meeting to "figure out

where Tyler County goes from here”. He requested the commissioners be open minded during budget workshop. The county auditor added she has been researching three different grants available.
