## Order AUTHORIZING 2023 MEMORIAL DAY FIREWORKS SALES

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court of Tyler County is authorized under Occupations Code Section §2154.202(h), to issue an order allowing retail fireworks permit holders to sell fireworks to the public in celebration of Memorial Day; and

**WHEREAS**, on the 22nd day of May, 2023, the Commissioners Court of Tyler County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Commissioners Court of Tyler County adopts this Order authorizing the sale of fireworks to the public by retail fireworks permit holders during the Memorial Day period beginning May 24, 2023 and ending at midnight May 29, 2023, subject to the following restrictions.

- a. This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county, or midnight, May 29, 2023, whichever is earlier.
