COMMENTS BY COURT MEMBERS PERTAINING TO MATTERS OF COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

John Settlocker- reported approval by the federal government for public assistance; total 31 homes affected: two destroyed, 10 major and 9 minor plus 10 more affected. He announced debris pick-up. Only chipping of debris is allowed- cannot burn.

Commissioner Hudson- expressed concern about dead trees along the power lines; generators expensive and hard to find

Judge Powers- people need monetary replacement of food being lost due to power outage; prayer for neighboring counties; thanked all for their aid and support

Auditor Skinner- requested pictures be taken for documentation of "leaners and hangers", required in the past by FEMA
