- WHEREAS, Older adults and people with disabilities of diverse backgrounds contribute to the wellbeing of this city by working, care giving, volunteering and actively preserving customs, rituals and traditions; and
- WHEREAS, as we age, we build momentum by accumulating knowledge, experience, insight, and wisdom, that can be shared to enrich our community; and
- WHEREAS, abuse against older adults and people with disabilities is a community concern, affecting thousands of people across Texas;
- WHEREAS, there were 123,852 reports of abuse of older adults and/or people with disabilities in Texas in 2024; and
- WHEREAS, abuse against older adults and people with disabilities is grossly underreported because of social stigma, embarrassment and fear; and
- WHEREAS, adult abuse effects men and women of all income and ability levels, all cultural and ethnic backgrounds, in all communities; and
- WHEREAS, elder abuse is everyone's business and it's important to strengthen our efforts to prevent, report and address elder abuse;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Milton Powers, Tyler County Judge, do hereby proclaim the month of June 2025 to be:

"Elder Abuse Awareness Month"
