Public Comments Information

Citizens are encouraged to speak to either their County Commissioner or the County Judge regarding matters of specific concern. Additionally, members of the public are limited to the role of observer unless they have signed up in advance to make comments. Persons who wish to make comments must notify the County Clerk's office at 409-283-2281 no later than 1 hour prior to the actual meeting time. You will be asked your name, the phone number you will be calling in from, and the topic you wish to bring before the Court. You will then be provided instructions to dial-in to this meeting to make your public comments at the designated time. Following the Court's customary guidelines, each member shall be allowed a maximum of five (5) minutes to make his/her remarks. Discussion on any specific topic will be restricted to 30 minutes total for all speakers on that topic to comment. Time for each speaker shall be maintained by the County Clerk or such other designated representative of the Commissioners Court.

An Emergency Meeting of the Tyler County Commissioners Court has been called to consider/approve and receive information directly relating to an urgent public necessity:

- 1) Continues to be significant eminent threat of Air Contamination to the citizens in Tyler County; and,
- 2) Due to the Eminent threat of Safety Issues caused by the Fire and Smoke in Tyler County and Surrounding counties in East Texas from a Tire Disposal Facility, and
- 3) Multiple Emergency Vehicle Response Teams were Used and Road Closures were Demanded, Creating a Public Safety Hazard.
